## 1. Introduction

The BOSS VE-8 Acoustic Singer is a compact, all-in-one preamp and effects solution designed for singers who play acoustic guitar. It provides studio-quality voice and guitar processing, real-time harmonies, and looping capabilities in a portable package. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your VE-8 unit.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

- Integrated Preamp and Effects: Combines vocal and acoustic guitar processing into a single, compact unit.
- Studio-Quality Vocal Processing: Includes four types of ambience effects, Enhance, and chromatic pitch correction for live vocal tuning.

- Multiple Vocal Effects: Features vocal doubling, hard-tuned electronic voices, distortion, and radio voice
  effects.
- **Dedicated Acoustic Guitar Channel:** Offers Acoustic Resonance, reverb, chorus, tuner, various effects, plus phase invert and notch filter for feedback control.
- Looper Functionality: Provides 80 seconds of recording time with independent looping for guitar and vocals.
- Intuitive Controls: Simple, intuitive controls for dialing in rich, sophisticated BOSS sound processing.

## 3. SETUP

# 3.1 Front Panel Overview

The front panel provides access to all primary controls for vocal and guitar effects, output levels, and memory functions.

## 3.2 Rear Panel Connections

The rear panel houses all input and output jacks for connecting your microphone, guitar, and external audio equipment.

# **Connecting Your Equipment:**

- 1. **Microphone Input:** Connect your microphone to the MIC IN (XLR) jack. Adjust the MIC SENS knob to an appropriate level.
- 2. Guitar Input: Connect your acoustic guitar to the GUITAR IN (1/4-inch) jack.

- 3. **Outputs:** Connect the XLR OUT (L/R) jacks to your PA system or mixer. Use the PHONES/LINE OUT jack for headphones or line-level output.
- 4. AUX IN: Connect an external audio player to the AUX IN jack for backing tracks.
- 5. **USB:** Connect to a computer for audio recording/playback or firmware updates.
- 6. **Power:** Connect the included BOSS PSA adaptor to the DC IN jack. Ensure the POWER ON/OFF switch is in the OFF position before connecting, then turn ON.

## 4. OPERATING THE VE-8

# **4.1 Vocal Section Controls**

- ENHANCE: Adjusts vocal clarity and presence.
- **CORRECT:** Applies chromatic pitch correction.
- REVERB (Type/Level): Selects reverb type and adjusts its intensity for vocals.
- HARMONY (Type/Level/Key): Selects harmony type (e.g., high, higher, low, double), adjusts its volume, and sets the key (AUTO or manual).

# **4.2 Guitar Section Controls**

- ACOUSTIC RESONANCE (Shape): Restores natural acoustic guitar tone.
- REVERB (Type): Selects reverb type for guitar.
- CHORUS (Type): Selects chorus type for guitar.
- NOTCH/PHASE: Controls feedback suppression.

# 4.3 Looper and Foot Switches

The three foot switches control Chorus, Harmony, and Looper functions. They also allow for memory selection and tuner activation.



- CHORUS Foot Switch: Toggles chorus effect. Press and hold for 2 seconds to activate the tuner and mute output.
- HARMONY Foot Switch: Toggles vocal harmony. Press and hold for 2 seconds to bypass all effects.
- LOOP Foot Switch: Controls looper functions (REC/PLAY, OVERDUB). Press twice to STOP, press and hold for 2 seconds to CLEAR the loop.
- STOMP/MEMORY: Use the foot switches to cycle through memory presets.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your BOSS VE-8, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the unit. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Storage: Store the unit in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Power Supply:** Always use the specified BOSS PSA adaptor. Disconnect power when not in use for extended periods.
- **Firmware Updates:** Periodically check the BOSS website for firmware updates to ensure your unit has the latest features and bug fixes.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your VE-8, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Sound:** Check all cable connections, ensure power is on, and verify input/output levels. Check if the unit is in Tuner/Mute mode.
- Distorted Sound: Reduce input gain (MIC SENS, GUITAR IN level) or output levels. Check for proper impedance matching.
- Feedback: Use the NOTCH/PHASE controls in the guitar section. Adjust microphone placement.
- Harmonies Not Tracking: Ensure the correct key is selected or AUTO mode is active. Check guitar input signal quality.
- Looper Issues: Ensure sufficient recording time is available (80 seconds max). Check if the loop is cleared correctly.
