1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Can-Am Overhead Front Audio System, Model 715003095. This rugged, waterproof Jensen Bluetooth Stereo Audio system is designed to enhance your off-road experience in compatible Can-Am Defender and Defender MAX vehicles. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure proper function and safety.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Improper Use of Off-Highway Vehicles Can Cause Severe Injury or Death.

- Be Prepared: Fasten seat belt and make sure nets or doors are securely latched in place.
- Each occupant must be able to sit with back against seat, feet flat on the floor or on footrests, and hands on handholds. Stay completely inside the vehicle.
- Drive Responsibly: Avoid abrupt maneuvers, sideways sliding, skidding or rolling, and never do donuts. Avoid hard acceleration when turning, even from a stop.
- Slow down before entering a turn.
- Plan for hills, rough terrain, ruts, and other changes in traction and terrain.
- Avoid paved surfaces.
- Avoid side hilling (riding across slopes).
- Do not put any part of your body outside of the vehicle.
- Read and understand all safety labels, locate and read operator's guide, and watch the safety video using the QR code link or visit Can-Am web site before operation.

Always ensure the audio system is securely mounted and all wiring is properly insulated to prevent interference with vehicle operation or potential hazards.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Can-Am Overhead Front Audio System requires specific vehicle components for installation. Ensure your vehicle has a Sport Roof (715002430, except on XT and Hunting Edition models), Front Roof Liner (715003098) or Deluxe Sport Roof (715002511), and Power Cable (715003094, unless a Hard Cab Enclosure 715001966 or 715003482 is already present).

4.1 Unboxing and Component Identification

Carefully unpack all components. Verify that all parts are present according to the packing list. The system includes the main audio unit, two speakers, and mounting hardware.

4.2 Mounting Bracket Assembly

Assemble the sturdy die-cast aluminum brackets using the provided screws and tools. Ensure all connections are tight and secure.

4.3 System Installation

Position the assembled brackets and audio unit into the overhead space of your Can-Am Defender. Secure the unit using the appropriate fasteners, ensuring a snug fit. Connect the power cable and any other necessary wiring as per your vehicle's specific wiring diagram. The system is designed for easy installation, often taking less than an hour.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your audio system features a convenient white LED-backlit LCD display and intuitive buttons for easy control.

5.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button (usually marked with a power symbol) to turn the system on or off. The LCD display will illuminate.

5.2 Source Selection

Use the 'SRC' or 'Source' button to cycle through available audio sources: AM, FM, WB (Weather Band), and USB. The selected source will be displayed on the LCD.

5.3 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure your mobile device's Bluetooth is enabled.
2. On the audio system, select the Bluetooth source. The system will enter pairing mode.
3. On your mobile device, search for available Bluetooth devices and select 'Rockford Fosgate' or a similar name.
4. Once connected, you can stream audio from your device. The system supports voice-control of AVRCP-active devices.

5.4 Radio Operation

For AM/FM/WB, use the tuning buttons to find stations. The system supports 30 programmable stations with auto-store/pre-set scan functions.

5.5 USB Playback

Connect your iPod or iPhone via the USB input to play music directly through the system.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your waterproof audio system, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the exterior. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure all covers and caps are securely closed to maintain waterproof integrity.
- **Connections:** Periodically check all wiring connections for tightness and corrosion. Apply dielectric grease to exposed electrical connections if operating in wet or harsh environments.
- **Speaker Grilles:** Keep speaker grilles free from debris, mud, or excessive dust to prevent sound obstruction.
- **Storage:** If storing the vehicle for an extended period, ensure the audio system is clean and dry.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Loose power connection, blown fuse, vehicle battery low.	Check all power connections, inspect fuses, ensure vehicle battery is charged.
No sound	Volume too low, incorrect source selected, speaker wires loose/disconnected, Bluetooth not paired.	Increase volume, select correct source, check speaker wiring, re-pair Bluetooth device.
Bluetooth not connecting	Device out of range, Bluetooth not enabled on device, interference.	Ensure device is within range, enable Bluetooth, try pairing again, move away from other electronic devices.
Poor radio reception	Weak signal, antenna issue.	Relocate vehicle for better signal, check antenna connection and condition.
