1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and save these instructions before using this fan. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or injury.

- Always unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning, servicing, or moving it.
- Do not operate any fan with a damaged cord or plug. Discard fan or return to an authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
- Do not insert or allow fingers or foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the fan.
- Do not block air openings or operate near curtains or other materials that could block airflow.
- This fan is ETL listed, ensuring it meets recognized safety standards.
- Built-in overload protection is provided for safety during extended use.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Hurricane Pro Floor Fan is designed for guick and easy assembly.

Assembly Steps:

- 1. Unpack all components from the box and ensure all parts are present.
- 2. Attach the U-shaped tube base to the main fan body. Align the holes and secure with the provided screws or fasteners.
- 3. Ensure the rubber feet are securely attached to the bottom of the tube base for stability and to prevent scratching surfaces.
- 4. Place the fan on a stable, level surface.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to operate your Hurricane Pro Floor Fan.

Powering On/Off:

- Plug the 6 ft power cord into a standard 120V electrical outlet.
- Locate the pull chain switch, typically at the rear or side of the fan motor housing.
- Pull the chain once to turn the fan on to its lowest speed setting.
- Continue pulling the chain to cycle through speed settings (Low, Medium, High) and then Off.

Speed Control:

The fan features three distinct speed settings to adjust airflow intensity:

- Low: For gentle air circulation.
- Medium: For moderate airflow.
- High: For maximum air velocity (5300 CFM).

Adjusting Tilt:

The fan head can be tilted to direct airflow upwards or downwards. Loosen the adjustment knobs on either side of the fan head, tilt to the desired angle, and then securely tighten the knobs.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your fan.

Cleaning:

- · Always unplug the fan before cleaning.
- Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the exterior surfaces of the fan.
- To clean the fan blades, the front grille can be removed. Refer to the assembly section for reverse steps if needed. Use a soft cloth to wipe dust from the blades.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these may damage the finish.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before plugging the fan back in.

Storage:

- Store the fan in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- If storing for an extended period, cover the fan to protect it from dust.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on	No power; Loose plug; Overload protection tripped	Check power outlet; Ensure plug is fully inserted; Reset circuit breaker or wait for fan to cool down.
Reduced airflow	Dirty blades/grille; Obstruction	Clean fan blades and grilles; Remove any obstructions.
Unusual noise or vibration	Loose parts; Fan not on level surface; Debris in fan	Check for loose screws and tighten; Place fan on a stable, level surface; Unplug and inspect for debris.
