## INTRODUCTION


## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Blomberg 4911630300 is an original equipment manufacturer (OEM) ice maker designed as a direct replacement part for compatible Blomberg refrigerators. It ensures your appliance continues to produce ice efficiently.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the Blomberg 4911630300 Ice Maker typically involves replacing an existing unit. Ensure you have the correct model (4911630300) as there might be similar models with different plug configurations.

1. **Disconnect Power:** Unplug the refrigerator from the power outlet or turn off the circuit breaker supplying power to the appliance.
2. **Access Ice Maker Compartment:** Open the freezer door and locate the existing ice maker. You may need to remove the ice bucket and any shelves obstructing access.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed and powered, the Blomberg 4911630300 Ice Maker operates automatically. It will fill with water, freeze the water into cubes, and then eject the ice into the ice bucket.

- **Ice Production:** The ice maker will cycle automatically as needed to keep the ice bucket full.
- **Ice Level Sensor:** Most refrigerators have an ice level sensor (often a wire arm or optical sensor) that stops ice production when the bucket is full. Ensure this sensor is not obstructed.
- **Water Supply:** Ensure the refrigerator's water supply line is connected and the water shut-off valve is open for the ice maker to function.

## MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure optimal performance and longevity of your ice maker.

- **Cleaning the Ice Bucket:** Periodically remove and wash the ice bucket with mild soap and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before returning it to the freezer.
- **Water Filter Replacement:** If your refrigerator has a water filter, replace it according to the manufacturer's recommendations (typically every 6 months) to ensure clean ice and proper water flow to the ice maker.
- **Inspect Water Line:** Occasionally check the water supply line for kinks or leaks.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Blomberg 4911630300 Ice Maker is not functioning as expected, review the following common issues before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	Refrigerator not connected to water supply; water valve closed; freezer temperature too high; ice maker power switch off; clogged water filter.	Ensure water supply is connected and valve is open. Check freezer temperature (should be 0°F/-18°C). Verify ice maker power switch is ON. Replace water filter if necessary.
Small or hollow ice cubes.	Low water pressure; clogged water filter; partially frozen water line.	Check water pressure. Replace water filter. Thaw any frozen water lines (disconnect power first).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker producing too much ice / not stopping.	Ice level sensor obstructed or faulty.	Ensure nothing is blocking the ice level sensor arm or optical sensor. If the sensor is faulty, it may require replacement.
Ice has an unusual taste or odor.	Old ice; dirty ice bucket; old water filter; food odors in freezer.	Discard old ice. Clean ice bucket. Replace water filter. Store strong-smelling foods in airtight containers.
