1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Hisense 32-inch 720p LCD TV, model 32H3B1. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your television to ensure proper use and to maximize your viewing experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this television to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury.

- Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Do not install near any heat sources.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack your television and ensure all items are present:

- Hisense 32-inch 720p LCD TV (Model 32H3B1)
- TV Stand (2 pieces)
- Remote Control
- Power Cord
- Screws for Stand Assembly
- User Manual (this document)

4. SETUP

4.1 Attaching the TV Stand

1. Place the TV face down on a soft, clean surface to prevent screen damage.
2. Align each stand piece with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure each stand piece with the provided screws using a screwdriver. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

4.2 Wall Mounting (Optional)

This TV is compatible with VESA standard wall mounts. For wall mounting, remove the stand and follow the instructions provided with your wall mount kit. Ensure the wall mount can support the weight of the TV (approximately 10.8 pounds).

4.3 Connecting External Devices

Your TV offers multiple input options for connecting various devices.

- **HDMI:** Connect Blu-ray players, game consoles, or cable/satellite boxes. The TV has 3 HDMI inputs.
- **USB:** Connect USB drives for media playback. The TV has 1 USB input.
- **RF Input:** Connect an antenna or cable for over-the-air or basic cable channels.
- **RCA Component/Composite:** Connect older devices like DVD players or VCRs.
- **Digital Audio Output:** Connect to a soundbar or home theater system for enhanced audio.

4.4 Powering On

1. Connect the power cord to the TV's power input and then to a wall outlet.
2. Press the **Power** button on the remote control or on the TV itself.
3. The TV will display the Hisense logo and then the initial setup screen (if it's the first power-on).

5. OPERATING YOUR TV

5.1 Remote Control Functions

Familiarize yourself with the remote control for easy navigation.

- **Power:** Turns the TV on or off.
- **Input:** Selects the input source (HDMI 1, HDMI 2, AV, etc.).
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts the volume level.
- **Channel +/-:** Changes TV channels.
- **Menu:** Accesses the main menu for settings adjustments.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Moves cursor in menus.
- **OK/Enter:** Confirms selections.

5.2 Selecting an Input Source

To switch between connected devices:

1. Press the **Input** button on your remote control.
2. Use the **Up/Down** navigation buttons to highlight the desired input source (e.g., HDMI 1, AV).
3. Press the **OK** button to select it.

5.3 Adjusting Picture and Sound Settings

To customize your viewing and listening experience:

1. Press the **Menu** button on your remote.
2. Navigate to **Picture** or **Sound** settings using the navigation buttons.
3. Select the desired setting (e.g., Brightness, Contrast, Bass, Treble) and adjust using the **Left/Right** buttons.
4. Press **Menu** again to exit.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning Your TV

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive screen cleaner. Never spray cleaner directly onto the screen.
- Avoid using alcohol, benzene, thinners, or other volatile substances.

6.2 Storage

If you need to store the TV, ensure it is kept in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. It is recommended to use the original packaging for protection during storage or transport.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, try the following solutions for common issues:

Problem	Possible Solution
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Problem	Possible Solution
No power	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the TV and the wall outlet. Test the outlet with another device.
No picture, but sound is present	Ensure the correct input source is selected. Check cable connections to external devices.
No sound, but picture is present	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. Verify audio cable connections.
Remote control not working	Replace the batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
Poor picture quality	Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness). Check the quality of the input signal or source device.


