## Setup

- Insert Batteries:** Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the recorder. Insert the two supplied LR03 (size AAA) alkaline batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the cover securely.
- Power On:** Press and hold the POWER button until the display lights up.
- Initial Settings:** The first time you power on the device, you may be prompted to set the date, time, and language. Follow the on-screen instructions using the navigation buttons.
- Memory Card (Optional):** If you wish to expand storage, insert a microSD card into the designated slot. The device supports microSD cards for additional recording capacity.

## Operating Instructions

### Recording Audio

The ICD-UX560 offers versatile recording options to suit different environments:

- **Normal Recording:** Standard mode for general voice recording.
- **Focus Recording:** Optimizes for capturing a single voice from a distance, reducing background noise.
- **Wide-Stereo Recording:** Ideal for capturing a broader sound field, such as meetings or music, utilizing the built-in stereo microphone.

To start recording, press the REC/PAUSE button. Press it again to pause, and press the STOP button to end and save the recording.

## Quick Charge Function

The device supports quick charging via USB. A 3-minute charge can provide up to 1 hour of recording time, ensuring you're always ready to capture important audio.

## User Interface and Recording Level Indicator

The intuitive user interface simplifies navigation and file searching. The LCD backlight ensures visibility in various lighting conditions. Monitor recording levels using the on-screen indicator to prevent distortion and ensure clear audio.
