INTRODUCTION

The Scheppach BCH5200PB is a powerful and versatile 2-in-1 gasoline-powered brush cutter and trimmer designed for efficient garden and landscape maintenance. It is engineered to handle various tasks, from trimming grass to cutting through dense brush and undergrowth. Featuring a robust 1.8 HP 2-stroke engine, anti-vibration technology, and an adjustable bicycle handle, this tool ensures comfortable and fatigue-free operation. Its lightweight design and easy controls make it suitable for both experienced users and those new to power gardening tools.



SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always prioritize safety when operating the Scheppach BCH5200PB. Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury or damage to the equipment.

- Read the Manual: Before operation, thoroughly read and understand all instructions in this manual.
- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Always wear appropriate PPE, including safety glasses or a face shield, hearing protection, heavy-duty gloves, long pants, and sturdy, non-slip footwear.
- Fuel Handling: Handle gasoline with extreme care. Store fuel in approved containers, in a well-ventilated area, away from ignition sources. Never refuel while the engine is running or hot.
- Work Area: Clear the work area of debris, rocks, and other objects that could be thrown by the cutting attachment. Keep bystanders, children, and pets at a safe distance (at least 15 meters/50 feet).
- Inspection: Before each use, inspect the brush cutter for loose parts, damage, or wear. Ensure all guards and

safety devices are in place and functioning correctly.

- **Engine Operation:** Do not operate the engine in an enclosed space. Ensure adequate ventilation to prevent carbon monoxide poisoning.
- Blade/Line Safety: Always turn off the engine and ensure the cutting attachment has stopped completely before performing any adjustments, maintenance, or clearing blockages.
- Anti-Vibration System: The integrated anti-vibration system helps reduce operator fatigue, but prolonged use still requires breaks.







SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Scheppach BCH5200PB:

- 1. Unpack: Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Check for any damage or missing parts.
- 2. **Assemble Shaft:** The shaft is split for transport. Connect the two halves securely according to the instructions, ensuring the locking mechanism engages.
- 3. **Attach Handlebar:** Mount the bicycle-style handlebar to the shaft at a comfortable working height. Tighten all fasteners securely.
- 4. **Install Guard:** Attach the blade guard to the lower part of the shaft, ensuring it is firmly in place to protect against debris.
- 5. Install Cutting Attachment:
 - For Trimmer Head: Secure the trimmer head with the double line onto the drive shaft.

- For 3-Tooth Blade: If using the blade, ensure the correct mounting hardware is used and the blade is oriented correctly.
- 6. **Attach Shoulder Strap:** Connect the shoulder strap to the designated attachment point on the shaft. Adjust the strap for comfortable and balanced operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to safely operate your brush cutter.

Fueling the Machine

The BCH5200PB uses a 2-stroke gasoline engine. It requires a specific fuel mixture.

- Fuel Mixture Ratio: Mix unleaded gasoline with high-quality 2-stroke engine oil at a ratio of 40:1 (Gasoline:Oil).
- Tank Capacity: The fuel tank has a capacity of 1.0 liter.

• Procedure:

- a. Ensure the engine is off and cool.
- b. Shake the pre-mixed fuel container thoroughly.
- c. Carefully open the fuel cap and fill the tank, avoiding spills. Do not overfill.
- d. Securely close the fuel cap.

Starting the Engine

- 1. Place the brush cutter on a flat, stable surface.
- 2. Engage the choke lever (if cold start).
- 3. Press the primer bulb several times until fuel is visible.
- 4. Pull the recoil starter cord firmly and smoothly until the engine starts. Do not pull the cord to its full extension.
- 5. Once the engine starts, gradually disengage the choke.
- 6. Allow the engine to warm up for a few moments before beginning operation.

Operating the Brush Cutter/Trimmer

- **Ergonomics:** Adjust the shoulder strap and handlebar to ensure a balanced and comfortable working position. The anti-vibration system helps reduce fatigue.
- Throttle Control: Use the throttle lever on the handle to control the engine speed and cutting attachment rotation.

The throttle lever lock ensures consistent speed during operation.

- Cutting Technique:
 - For Trimming Grass: Use a sweeping motion, keeping the trimmer head parallel to the ground. The Tap'n'Go function allows for easy line extension by tapping the head on the ground while running.
 - For Brush Cutting: Use the 3-tooth blade for thicker vegetation. Work in controlled, deliberate strokes. Be aware of kickback when cutting tough material.
- Applications: Suitable for cutting grass, weeds, and shrubs.




Image: Visual representation of the suitable applications for the Scheppach BCH5200PB, including shrubs, weeds, and grass.

Stopping the Engine

To stop the engine, simply press the stop switch located on the handle. Ensure the cutting attachment has come to a complete stop before setting the machine down.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Scheppach BCH5200PB.

- Cleaning: After each use, clean the exterior of the machine, especially the cutting head and guard, to remove grass, dirt, and debris. Do not use high-pressure water.
- Air Filter: Periodically inspect and clean the air filter. A clogged air filter can reduce engine performance. Replace if damaged.
- Spark Plug: Check the spark plug regularly. Clean or replace if it is fouled or worn.

• Cutting Attachments:

- Trimmer Line: Replace the trimmer line when it becomes too short or worn.
- Blade: Inspect the metal blade for sharpness and damage. Sharpen or replace as needed.
- Fuel System: If storing the machine for an extended period, drain the fuel tank and run the engine until it stops to clear the carburetor of fuel. This prevents fuel degradation issues.
- **General Inspection:** Regularly check all nuts, bolts, and screws for tightness. Lubricate moving parts as recommended in the full manual.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine does not start	No fuel or incorrect fuel mixture	Fill with correct 40:1 fuel mixture
Engine does not start	Spark plug fouled or wet	Clean or replace spark plug; dry if wet
Engine does not start	Choke not set correctly	Adjust choke lever as per starting instructions
Engine lacks power	Clogged air filter	Clean or replace air filter
Engine lacks power	Dull or damaged cutting attachment	Sharpen blade or replace trimmer line/blade
Excessive vibration	Loose components or damaged blade	Check all fasteners; inspect and replace damaged blade
