1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides instructions for the KeylessOption Keyless Entry Remote Car Key Fob and Key Replacement, model KPT4034. This product is designed to function as a direct replacement for your original vehicle's keyless entry remote and ignition key, ensuring compatibility and reliable performance. It comes fully tested with a pre-installed battery and includes resources for self-programming the remote and cutting the key.

4. SETUP & PROGRAMMING

This section outlines the steps required to prepare your new key fob and key for use with your vehicle.

4.1. Remote Fob Programming (DIY)

The keyless entry remote is designed for DIY (Do-It-Yourself) programming, provided you have at least one currently working key for your vehicle. Detailed step-by-step instructions are typically included with your purchase or can be found on the KeylessOption website. The general process involves a sequence of ignition turns and button presses to synchronize the new remote with your vehicle's system. Ensure all existing remotes are present during the programming process, as they may need to be reprogrammed simultaneously.

4.2. Ignition Key Cutting

The included ignition key is uncut and requires professional cutting to match your vehicle's existing key. This process does not involve electronic programming. Take the uncut key and your original working key to a qualified locksmith or an automotive dealership for cutting. Once cut, the key will function mechanically to start your vehicle.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your key fob is programmed and your key is cut, you can begin using them with your vehicle.

- **Lock Button:** Press the **Lock** button once to lock all vehicle doors. Some vehicles may provide an audible confirmation (e.g., horn chirp) or visual confirmation (e.g., lights flash).
- **Unlock Button:** Press the **Unlock** button once to unlock the driver's door. Press it a second time within a few seconds to unlock all other vehicle doors.
- **Panic Button:** Press and hold the **Panic** button (often indicated by a horn icon) for approximately 2-3 seconds to activate the vehicle's alarm system. Release the button to deactivate the alarm.
- **Ignition Key:** Insert the cut key into the ignition cylinder and turn to the "ON" or "START" position to start the vehicle. Use the key to manually lock or unlock doors if the remote is not functioning or preferred.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life of your KeylessOption product.

6.1. Battery Replacement

The keyless entry remote uses a CR2032 lithium coin cell battery. If the remote's range decreases significantly or it stops responding, the battery may need replacement. To replace the battery:

1. Carefully pry open the remote casing using a small flat-head screwdriver or a coin at the designated notch.
2. Note the orientation of the old battery before removing it.
3. Insert a new CR2032 battery with the positive (+) side facing up.
4. Snap the remote casing back together firmly until it clicks into place.

No reprogramming is typically required after battery replacement.

6.2. General Care

- Avoid exposing the key fob to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, or excessive moisture.
- Do not drop the key fob or subject it to strong impacts.
- Clean the exterior of the key fob with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your KeylessOption product, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote does not work after programming.	Incorrect programming steps; battery low or dead; remote not compatible.	Re-attempt programming carefully following all steps. Replace the battery (CR2032). Verify vehicle compatibility with the remote's part numbers.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote range is poor.	Low battery; interference; obstruction.	Replace the battery (CR2032). Ensure no large metal objects or electronic devices are blocking the signal. Try operating closer to the vehicle.
Key does not turn in ignition or door.	Key not cut correctly; wrong key blank.	Contact the locksmith or dealership that cut the key for re-evaluation. Verify the key blank (B102P) is correct for your vehicle.
