## INTRODUCTION

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This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Project Nursery 5-inch High Definition Baby Monitor System with a 1.5-inch Mini Monitor. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and safety. Keep this manual for future reference.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Project Nursery Baby Monitor System consists of a primary 5-inch High Definition parent unit, a compact 1.5-inch mini monitor for portability, and a camera unit for monitoring your baby.

### 5-inch HD Parent Unit

This is the main monitor for viewing your baby with a large, clear display. It features intuitive controls for various functions.

### **1.5-inch Mini Monitor**

A smaller, portable monitor designed for convenience, allowing you to keep an eye on your baby while moving around the house.

### **Baby Unit (Camera)**

The camera unit captures video and audio from your baby's room and transmits it to the parent units. It features remote pan/tilt/zoom and infrared night vision.

## SETUP

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### 1. Charging the Monitors

Before first use, fully charge both the 5-inch HD Parent Unit and the 1.5-inch Mini Monitor. Connect the appropriate power adapters to each monitor and a power outlet. The charging indicator will illuminate.

### 2. Positioning the Camera

Place the Baby Unit (camera) in a location that provides a clear view of your baby's crib or play area. Ensure it is out of reach of children and cords are secured to prevent strangulation hazards. The camera can be wall-mounted or placed on a flat surface.

### 3. Powering On

Connect the Baby Unit (camera) to a power outlet using its dedicated power adapter. Press and hold the Power button on both parent units to turn them on. The units should automatically connect to the camera. If not, refer to the 'Pairing' section.

### 4. Pairing Additional Cameras (Optional)

Your system comes pre-paired. If you purchase additional cameras (up to 4 total), you will need to pair them. Consult the on-screen menu of your 5-inch HD Parent Unit for pairing instructions. Typically, this involves selecting 'Add Camera' from the menu and pressing a pairing button on the new camera unit.

## OPERATING THE 5-INCH HD PARENT UNIT

### Basic Controls

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off. Press briefly to turn screen on/off.
- **Menu Button:** Access system settings and features.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Navigate menus and control camera pan/tilt.
- **OK/Zoom Button:** Confirm selections and digitally zoom in/out on the camera feed.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust audio volume from the camera.
- **Talk Button:** Press and hold to speak to your baby through the camera's speaker.

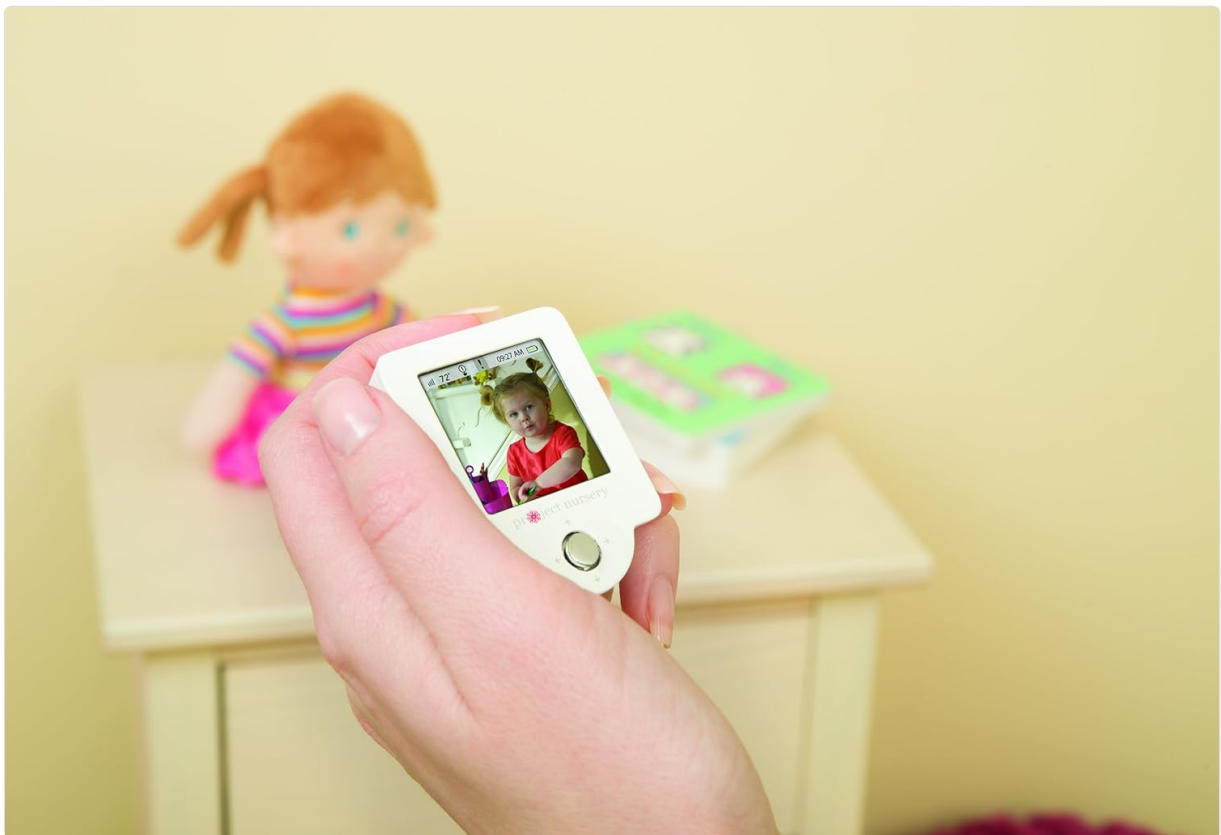

### Key Features

- **Remote Pan/Tilt/Zoom:** Use the navigation buttons to adjust the camera's view remotely.
- **Infrared Night Vision:** Automatically activates in low light conditions for clear viewing in the dark.
- **Two-Way Talk:** Communicate with your baby using the Talk button.
- **Lullabies, White Noise, and Natural Sounds:** Select from pre-programmed sounds to soothe your baby.



- **Room Temperature Sensor:** Displays the temperature of your baby's room on the monitor.
- **Motion, Temperature, and Sound Detection Alerts:** Receive notifications if specific thresholds are met.
- **Video Recording and Photo Snapshots:** Insert a micro SD card (not included) to record video or capture photos directly from the monitor.
- **Multi-Camera Support:** Pair up to 4 cameras and view them in single, split, or quad view modes.

## OPERATING THE 1.5-INCH MINI MONITOR

The 1.5-inch Mini Monitor provides a convenient, portable way to monitor your baby.

### Basic Controls

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Used for basic menu navigation and digital zoom.
- **OK/Zoom Button:** Confirm selections and activate digital zoom.

The Mini Monitor offers essential video and audio monitoring. For advanced features like remote pan/tilt, lullabies, or detailed settings, use the 5-inch HD Parent Unit.

## MAINTENANCE

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### Cleaning

Wipe the monitor and camera surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure all units are unplugged before cleaning.

### Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the monitors frequently. Charge them regularly. If storing the units for an extended period, charge them fully before storage and recharge every few months.

### Storage

Store the system in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No picture/sound on monitor	Units not powered on; Out of range; Not paired; Low battery.	Ensure all units are powered on and charged. Move parent unit closer to camera. Re-pair units if necessary (refer to 'Setup' section).
Poor picture quality	Weak signal; Obstructions; Low light.	Reduce distance between units. Remove obstructions. Ensure camera lens is clean. Night vision should activate automatically in low light.
Static or interference	Other electronic devices; Out of range.	Move monitor away from other electronics (Wi-Fi routers, microwaves). Move parent unit closer to camera.
Monitor not holding charge	Battery degradation; Improper charging.	Ensure power adapter is securely connected. Allow for a full charge cycle. If battery life remains poor, battery may need replacement.









Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote pan/tilt/zoom not working	Out of range; Camera frozen.	Move parent unit closer to camera. Power cycle the camera unit (unplug and plug back in).
