# LG GSL760PZXV Refrigerator User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your LG GSL760PZXV Side-by-Side Refrigerator. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and keep it for future reference.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your refrigerator.

- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Unplug the refrigerator before cleaning or performing maintenance.
- Keep flammable materials and vapors away from the refrigerator.

## SETUP

### Unpacking

Remove all packaging materials, tape, and protective film from the refrigerator. Dispose of packaging materials responsibly.

### Placement

Place the refrigerator on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and moisture. Ensure adequate space around the unit for proper ventilation. The dimensions of the product are approximately 91.2 cm (width) x 73.8 cm (depth) x 179 cm (height).

## Leveling

Adjust the leveling feet to ensure the refrigerator is stable and level. This helps prevent vibrations and ensures proper door closure.

## Water Connection (for Ice Maker/Dispenser)

For models with an ice maker and water dispenser, connect the refrigerator to a potable water supply. Refer to the detailed installation guide for specific plumbing instructions. This model requires a direct water connection.

## Power Connection

Plug the power cord into a dedicated, grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

## Initial Operation

After connecting power, allow the refrigerator to cool down for several hours before loading food. The internal temperature will stabilize over time.

### Temperature Control

Use the integrated display screen to adjust the temperature settings for both the refrigerator and freezer compartments. Refer to the display for current temperature readings.

### Key Features

- **Magic Air Humidity Control:** Regulates humidity within the fresh vegetable drawer to keep produce fresh longer.

- **Artica Door Ice Maker:** Located in the freezer door, this ice maker provides convenient access to ice while maximizing shelf space inside the freezer.

- **Door Alarm:** Alerts you if a door is left open, helping to conserve energy.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

Regularly clean the interior and exterior of your refrigerator with a mild detergent and warm water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents. For stainless steel surfaces, use a specialized stainless steel cleaner.

### Defrosting

This refrigerator features an automatic defrosting system, eliminating the need for manual defrosting.

### Care of Interior Components

Removable shelves and drawers can be washed with warm, soapy water. Ensure they are completely dry before placing them back into the refrigerator.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your refrigerator, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Check power connection, temperature settings, and ensure doors are fully closed.
Door alarm sounds frequently	Ensure doors are not obstructed and close completely. Check door seals for damage.
Unusual noises	Check if the refrigerator is level. Normal operating noises include compressor hum and refrigerant flow.
Water dispenser not working	Verify water supply connection and ensure the water filter is not clogged.
