NTRODUCTION

The Poly Voyager 5200 is a single-ear Bluetooth headset designed for mobile professionals who require clear communication on the go. It features advanced noise-canceling technology and an ergonomic design for all-day comfort. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your headset.

Key features include:

- Crystal clear Bluetooth audio quality with triple-mic active Digital Signal Processing (DSP) and wind canceling.
- Up to 7 hours of talk time and a roaming range of up to 98 feet (30 meters).
- Ergonomic design rigorously tested for stability and comfort on a wide range of ear shapes.
- Voice controls for answering/ignoring calls and activating virtual assistants like Siri, Google Assistant, or Cortana.
- Moisture-resistant P2i coating for durability.




Image: Front view of the Poly Voyager 5200 Wireless Headset, showcasing its ergonomic design and control buttons.




Image: Side view of the Poly Voyager 5200 Wireless Headset, highlighting its over-ear wearing style and comfortable fit.

Headset Components:

- Power Switch: Located on the main body, used to turn the headset on or off.
- Call Button: Typically on the side, used to answer, end, or reject calls.
- Volume Buttons: Usually two distinct buttons for increasing and decreasing audio volume.
- Mute Button: A dedicated button to mute or unmute the microphone during calls.
- **Microphone Boom:** Extends from the main body to position the microphones closer to your mouth for clear voice pickup.
- Charging Port: Micro USB port for connecting the charging cable.
- Ear Tip: Replaceable silicone tip that fits into your ear canal for comfort and sound delivery.

SETUP

1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge your headset. Connect the micro USB end of the charging cable to the headset's charging port and the USB-A end to a USB wall charger or a computer's USB port. The charging indicator light will show the charging status. A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours and provides up to 7 hours of talk time.

2. Pairing with a Mobile Device

To connect your headset to your mobile phone or tablet via Bluetooth:

- 1. Turn on your headset by sliding the power switch.
- 2. Activate Bluetooth on your mobile device.
- 3. Put the headset into pairing mode. This is usually done by pressing and holding the Call button until the indicator light flashes red and blue, or a voice prompt says "pairing."
- 4. On your mobile device, search for new Bluetooth devices. Select "Poly Voyager 5200" from the list of available devices.
- 5. If prompted, enter the passcode "0000" (four zeros).
- 6. Once paired, the headset indicator light will stop flashing and a voice prompt will confirm the connection.

3. Fitting the Headset

The Voyager 5200 comes with small, medium, and large ear tips to ensure a comfortable and secure fit. Experiment with different sizes to find the one that best suits your ear. The headset is designed to be worn over the ear, with the microphone boom positioned towards your mouth for optimal voice clarity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Call Management

- Answer/End Call: Press the Call button once.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the Call button for 2 seconds.
- Mute/Unmute: Press the Mute button during an active call.
- **Transfer Audio:** During a call, press and hold the Call button for 2 seconds to transfer audio between your phone and headset.

Voice Controls and Assistant

The headset supports voice commands and integration with your phone's virtual assistant:

- When an incoming call rings, you can say "Answer" or "Ignore" to manage the call hands-free.
- Press the dedicated voice control button to activate Siri, Google Assistant, or Cortana on your connected smartphone.

Audio Streaming

The Voyager 5200 can stream audio from your mobile device, including music, podcasts, and GPS directions. Use your phone's media controls to play, pause, or skip tracks.

Multi-point Connectivity

Your headset can connect to two mobile devices simultaneously. This allows you to seamlessly switch between calls or audio from different devices without re-pairing.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Regularly clean your headset to ensure optimal performance and hygiene. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the headset. For the ear tip, you may gently remove it and clean with a damp cloth and mild soap, ensuring it is completely dry before reattaching.

Storage

When not in use, store your headset in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight. Avoid storing it with sharp objects that could scratch or damage the device.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Sound or Poor Audio Quality

- Ensure the headset is charged and powered on.
- Check that the headset is properly paired and connected to your device.
- Increase the volume on both the headset and your connected device.
- Move closer to your device; the maximum range is 98 feet (30 meters).
- Ensure there are no obstructions or strong interference sources (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, other Bluetooth devices) between the headset and your device.
- Try re-pairing the headset with your device.

Cannot Pair Headset

- Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (indicator light flashing red and blue).
- Turn off and then on your mobile device's Bluetooth.
- Delete the headset from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.
- Ensure the headset is not already connected to another device (due to multi-point feature).

Voice Commands Not Responding

- Ensure your phone's voice assistant is enabled and configured correctly.
- Speak clearly and directly into the microphone.
- Check for firmware updates for your headset via the Poly app (if available).
