SETUP

- 1. **Connect to Computer:** Insert the USB connector of the SABRENT AU-DDAB adapter into an available USB port on your computer. The operating system will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers.
- 2. Connect Audio Output: Plug your headphones or speakers into the green 3.5mm audio output jack on the adapter.
- 3. Connect Microphone (Optional): If using a microphone, plug it into the pink 3.5mm microphone input jack on the

adapter.

4. Verify Device Recognition:

- Windows: Go to "Sound Settings" (right-click the speaker icon in the taskbar) and ensure "USB Audio Device" is selected as the default playback and recording device.
- Mac: Go to "System Preferences" > "Sound" and select "USB Audio Device" for both input and output.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SABRENT AU-DDAB adapter features integrated controls for convenient audio management.

- Volume Up Button: Press to increase the audio output volume.
- Volume Down Button: Press to decrease the audio output volume.
- Speaker Mute Button: Press to mute or unmute the audio output. An LED indicator will show the mute status.
- Microphone Mute Button: Press to mute or unmute the microphone input. An LED indicator will show the mute status.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound output.	 Adapter not properly connected. Incorrect default audio device selected. Speaker mute activated. Volume too low. 	 Ensure the adapter is fully inserted into the USB port. Verify "USB Audio Device" is set as the default playback device in your operating system's sound settings. Press the speaker mute button to unmute. Increase volume using the adapter's volume up button or system volume controls.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Microphone not working.	 Microphone not properly connected. Incorrect default recording device selected. Microphone mute activated. 	 Ensure the microphone is fully inserted into the pink jack. Verify "USB Audio Device" is set as the default recording device in your operating system's sound settings. Press the microphone mute button to unmute.
Device not recognized.	Faulty USB port.Temporary system glitch.	 Try connecting the adapter to a different USB port. Restart your computer.
