INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Kawai Grand Piano Model 1144. Designed with a focus on expressive play and enhanced safety, this 32-key mini grand piano offers a unique musical experience. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and longevity of your instrument.

1. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all parts are present, including the main piano unit and the four legs. Retain packaging for future transport or storage.

1.2 Assembly of Legs

The Kawai Grand Piano Model 1144 requires minimal assembly, primarily attaching the four legs to the main body.

- 1. Gently place the piano upside down on a soft, stable surface to prevent scratching the finish.
- 2. Locate the four designated attachment points on the underside of the piano.
- 3. Align each leg with its corresponding attachment point.
- 4. Securely screw each leg into place. Do not overtighten.
- 5. Once all legs are attached, carefully turn the piano upright and place it on a flat, stable surface.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Basic Playback

The Kawai Grand Piano Model 1144 features an action mechanism designed for expressive play. Simply press down on any of the 32 keys to produce a sound. The instrument's sound source consists of aluminum pipes, producing clear, chime-like tones.

2.2 Sound Range

The piano has a sound range from F5 to C8, covering 32 keys. This range allows for a variety of melodies and harmonies suitable for learning and casual play.

2.3 Lid Operation

The piano features a movable lid that can be opened or closed, similar to a traditional grand piano. The lid can be propped open to enhance sound projection or closed for protection and aesthetics.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your piano:

- Wipe the wooden surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- For the keys, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed immediately by a dry cloth.
- Ensure no liquids enter the internal mechanisms of the piano.

3.2 Storage and Care

Store the piano in a stable environment, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity, which can affect the wood and internal components. The design incorporates increased strength in roof joints and keyboard construction for durability.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

4.1 No Sound or Muffled Sound

- Check for obstructions: Ensure no foreign objects are lodged between the keys or within the sound mechanism.
- **Key action:** Verify that each key moves freely and returns to its original position after being pressed.

4.2 Instability

- Leg tightness: Re-check that all four legs are securely screwed into the piano body.
- Surface: Ensure the piano is placed on a flat, level, and stable surface.
