1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

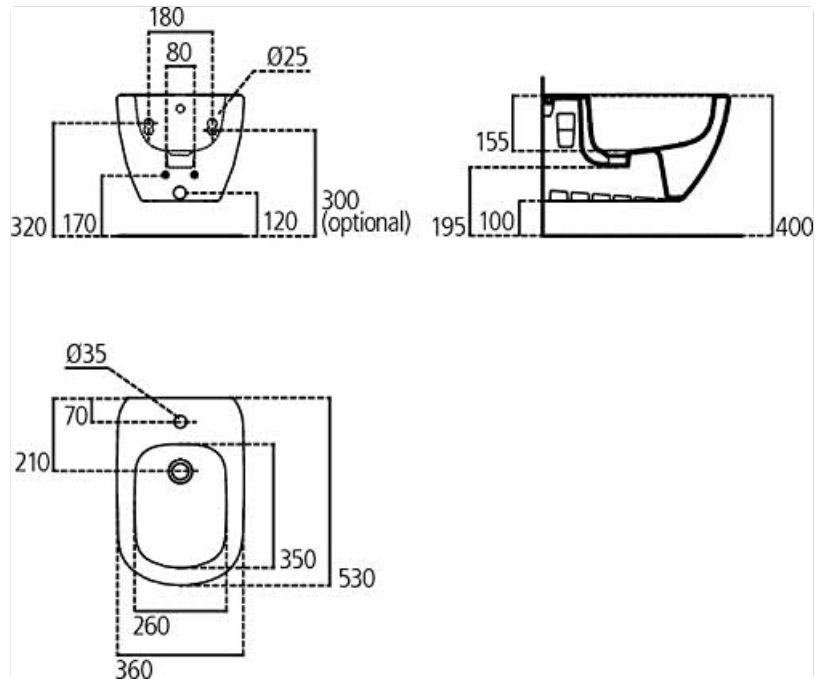


Figure 2: Technical drawing illustrating the dimensions and connection points for the Ideal Standard T355201 Suspended Tesi Bidet. Refer to these measurements for accurate installation planning.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Ideal Standard T355201 is a bidet bowl designed for personal hygiene. Its operation depends on the type of bidet faucet installed (not included with the bidet bowl).

3.1 Basic Use

1. Ensure the bidet faucet is properly installed and connected to both hot and cold water supplies.
2. Adjust the water temperature and flow using the faucet's controls to your preference.
3. Position yourself comfortably over the bidet bowl.
4. After use, turn off the water supply completely.

Note: Always test the water temperature before use to prevent scalding.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and pristine appearance of your Ideal Standard T355201 Bidet.

4.1 Cleaning

- Clean the bidet regularly with a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive bathroom cleaner.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive sponges, or scouring powders, as these can damage the high-gloss white finish.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water after cleaning and dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots.

4.2 General Care

- Periodically check all water connections for any signs of leaks.
- Ensure the bidet is securely mounted to the wall. If any looseness is detected, consult a professional.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bidet.

5.1 Water Leaks

- **Issue:** Water leaking from connections.
Solution: Turn off the main water supply. Check all pipe connections for tightness. Ensure sealing washers are correctly seated. If the leak persists, contact a qualified plumber.
- **Issue:** Water leaking from the bidet bowl itself.
Solution: Inspect the ceramic for cracks. If cracks are found, the bidet may need replacement.

5.2 Poor Water Flow

- **Issue:** Low water pressure or restricted flow from the faucet.
Solution: This is typically related to the faucet or the water supply lines, not the bidet bowl. Check the faucet's aerator for blockages. Ensure water supply valves are fully open. Consult the faucet's instruction manual or a plumber if issues persist.

5.3 Bidet Feels Loose

- **Issue:** The bidet feels unstable or loose on the wall.
Solution: This indicates an issue with the wall-hung frame or its fixings. Do not use the bidet if it is loose. Immediately contact a qualified installer to inspect and re-secure the installation.
