INTRODUCTION

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Each package contains the following items:

- Two (2) Magnadyne 6"x9" Speaker Grills
- Mounting Hardware: Eight (8) bolts and Eight (8) nuts

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Magnadyne 6x9 Speaker Grills are designed for versatile installation, accommodating most standard 6" x 9" speakers. They can be used for OEM installations or top-mount applications.

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Mounting Surface:** Ensure the surface where the speaker grill will be mounted is clean and free of obstructions.
2. **Position the Grill:** Place the speaker grill over your 6" x 9" speaker, aligning the mounting holes on the grill with the speaker's or mounting surface's holes.
3. **Secure with Hardware:** Use the provided bolts and nuts to secure the grill in place. Insert a bolt through each mounting hole on the grill and speaker/surface, then fasten with a nut from the underside. Tighten securely but do not overtighten to avoid damaging the grill or mounting surface.

The grills measure 1-1/8" deep, providing adequate clearance for most speaker cones.

USAGE CONSIDERATIONS

While primarily designed for speaker protection, these grills can also serve as circulation vents for various applications, such as arcade or slot machines, where airflow and protection are required.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and integrity of your Magnadyne speaker grills, follow these simple guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the grills with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the mounting hardware to ensure it remains tight. Retighten if necessary.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during installation or use, consider the following:

- **Grill Does Not Fit:** Verify that your speakers are standard 6" x 9" dimensions. While designed for most, some non-standard speaker frames may have unique mounting patterns or larger surrounds.
- **Mounting Hardware Issues:** The provided hardware consists of bolts and nuts. If your application requires screws (e.g., for wood mounting), you may need to source appropriate screws separately. Ensure all hardware is correctly aligned and tightened.
- **Vibration or Rattling:** Ensure all mounting bolts are securely tightened. Loose hardware can cause unwanted vibrations.

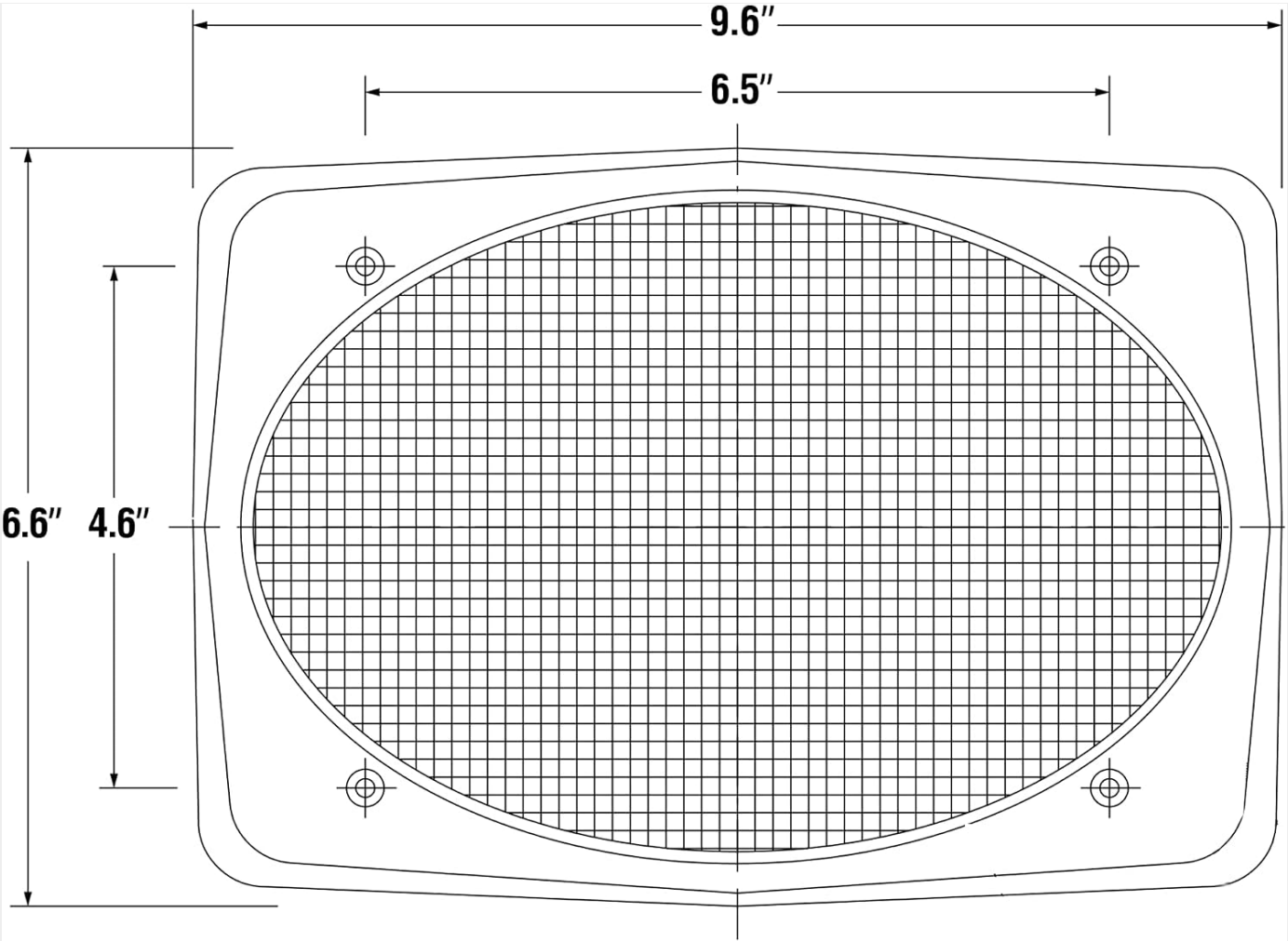


Image: Technical drawing showing the dimensions of the 6x9 speaker grill, including overall length, width, and mesh area.
