Cuisinart SCM-10P1 Snow Cone Maker Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

The Cuisinart Snow Cone Maker SCM-10P1 is designed to create shaved ice for snow cones, slushies, frozen lemonades, and other cold beverages. This appliance features a professional motor and blade mechanism with an interlock safety feature. It operates quickly, producing enough ice for 4-5 cones in under a minute. The unit includes a removable ice bin, a pull-out serving tray with two fold-down cone holders, four BPA-free reusable cones, and 12 paper cones. Recipes are also included to help you get started.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch moving parts. Keep hands, hair, clothing, and utensils away from the blade during operation to prevent injury.
- Always ensure the lid is securely closed before operating the machine. The interlock safety feature prevents operation if the lid is not properly in place.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids. Clean with a damp cloth.
- Supervise children closely when the appliance is in use. This appliance is not intended for use by children.
- Unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Use only attachments recommended or sold by the manufacturer.
- Do not use outdoors.

PARTS & FEATURES

The Cuisinart SCM-10P1 Snow Cone Maker is designed for ease of use and durability. Key components include:

- **Motor Base:** Houses the powerful motor and controls.
- **Ice Shaving Chamber:** Where ice cubes are placed for shaving.

- **Plunger/Handle:** Used to press ice down onto the shaving blade.
- **Shaving Blade:** Stainless steel blade for efficient ice shaving.
- **Removable Ice Bin:** Collects the shaved ice.
- **Pull-Out Serving Tray:** Features two fold-down cone holders for convenient serving.
- **On/Off Switch:** Simple control for operation.
- **Accessories:** Includes 4 reusable plastic cones, 12 paper cones, and an ice scoop.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Wash the removable ice bin, serving tray, reusable cones, and ice scoop in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth.
3. **Assemble:** Place the motor base on a clean, dry, and stable surface. Ensure the removable ice bin is correctly seated in the base.
4. **Position:** Extend the pull-out serving tray and fold down the cone holders if desired.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Prepare Ice:** Use standard ice cubes from your freezer. For best results, avoid overly large or irregularly shaped ice cubes.
2. **Add Ice:** Open the top lid of the ice shaving chamber. Carefully place ice cubes into the chamber. Do not

overflow.

3. **Close Lid:** Securely close the top lid. The machine will not operate unless the lid is properly locked into place due to the safety interlock.
4. **Position Cone:** Place a reusable or paper cone on the serving tray directly under the ice chute.
5. **Activate Shaving:** Plug the appliance into a standard electrical outlet. Flip the On/Off switch to the 'On' position. Press down firmly on the plunger/handle to push the ice cubes onto the shaving blade.

6. **Collect Shaved Ice:** The shaved ice will dispense directly into the cone. Continue pressing the plunger until the desired amount of shaved ice is collected. The machine can produce enough ice for 4-5 cones in under a minute.

7. **Turn Off:** Release the plunger and flip the On/Off switch to the 'Off' position when finished. Unplug the appliance.
8. **Add Syrup:** Drizzle your favorite snow cone syrup or juice over the shaved ice.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Cuisinart Snow Cone Maker.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.
2. **Disassemble:** Remove the top lid, plunger, and ice bin.
3. **Wash Removable Parts:** Wash the ice bin, serving tray, reusable cones, ice scoop, and top lid in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. These parts are generally top-rack dishwasher safe, but hand washing is recommended for best care.
4. **Clean Motor Base:** Wipe the exterior of the motor base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor base in water.
5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling or storing. Store the appliance in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Cuisinart Snow Cone Maker, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Machine Not Turning On:**

- Ensure the appliance is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Verify that the top lid is properly closed and locked into place. The safety interlock prevents operation if the lid is open.
- Check the On/Off switch is in the 'On' position.

- **Ice Not Shaving Properly:**

- Ensure you are pressing down firmly on the plunger/handle to push the ice onto the blade.
- Check that the ice cubes are not too large or frozen together. Break apart any large chunks.
- The blade may be dull. Contact customer support for assistance if the issue persists after trying the above steps.

- **Excessive Noise During Operation:**

- Some noise is normal during ice shaving.
- Ensure the machine is on a stable, flat surface.
- Check for any foreign objects in the ice shaving chamber.
