- **Avoid Scratches:** Prevent scratches by handling the CD carefully and avoiding rough surfaces. Deep scratches can affect playback quality.

- CD Not Playing/No Sound:
 - Ensure the CD is inserted correctly with the label side up.

 - Inspect the CD for visible damage or heavy smudges; clean if necessary.


• Skipping or Stuttering Playback:
