1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the SilverCrest Nose & Ear Hair Trimmer. This compact and robust trimmer is designed for precise and optimal hair removal from the nose and ears. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure safe and proper operation, and keep it for future reference.




Figure 1: Packaging of the SilverCrest Nose & Ear Hair Trimmer. The box displays the brand "SilverCrest Personal Care" and "Nose & Ear Hair Trimmer" with an image of the device.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe the following safety precautions to reduce the risk of injury or damage to the device.

- **General Safety:**

- Keep the device out of reach of children.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been

given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Do not use the device if it is damaged.
- Do not attempt to repair the device yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.

- **Battery Safety:**

- Only use the specified battery type (1x AA 1.5V).
- Ensure correct polarity when inserting batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- Remove batteries if the device will not be used for an extended period.
- Dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

- **Water Resistance (IPX4):**

- The device has an IPX4 splash-proof housing, meaning it is protected against splashing water from any direction.
- Do not immerse the device in water or use it under running water for extended periods.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Features:

- **Precision Trimming:** Designed for accurate hair removal.
- **Rotating Stainless Steel Blades:** Ensures optimal cutting performance.
- **IPX4 Splash-Proof Housing:** Protects against splashing water.
- **Compact and Easy-to-Use Design:** Ergonomic for comfortable handling.
- **Detachable Head with Steel Blade:** For easy cleaning and maintenance.
- **Battery Operated:** Requires 1x AA 1.5V battery (included).

4. SETUP

4.1 Battery Installation

The trimmer operates on one AA 1.5V battery. Follow these steps to install the battery:

1. Twist the bottom part of the trimmer counter-clockwise to open the battery compartment.
2. Insert one AA 1.5V battery, ensuring the correct polarity (+/-) as indicated inside the compartment.
3. Twist the bottom part clockwise to securely close the battery compartment.

4.2 Initial Preparation

- Remove the protective cap from the trimming head.
- Ensure the trimming head is clean before first use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Turning On/Off

- To turn on the trimmer, slide the ON/OFF switch upwards to the "ON" position.
- To turn off the trimmer, slide the ON/OFF switch downwards to the "OFF" position.

5.2 Trimming Nose Hair

1. Gently insert the trimming head into your nostril, ensuring it does not go too deep.
2. Move the trimmer in a circular motion to trim unwanted hair.
3. Breathe normally through your mouth during the process.

5.3 Trimming Ear Hair

1. Carefully insert the trimming head into the outer part of your ear canal.
2. Gently rotate the trimmer to remove visible hair.
3. Do not insert the trimmer too deeply into the ear canal to avoid injury.

Note: Always use the trimmer on clean, dry skin. Avoid pressing the trimmer too hard against the skin.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your trimmer.

6.1 Cleaning the Trimming Head

1. Ensure the trimmer is turned off before cleaning.
2. Twist the trimming head counter-clockwise to detach it from the main body.
3. Rinse the detachable trimming head under running water to remove hair clippings.
4. You may use the included cleaning brush (if applicable) to remove stubborn hair.
5. Allow the trimming head to air dry completely before reattaching it to the main body.
6. Do not rinse the main body of the trimmer under water. Wipe it with a damp cloth if necessary.

6.2 Storage

- Replace the protective cap on the trimming head after each use.
- Store the trimmer in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- If storing for an extended period, remove the battery to prevent leakage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Trimmer does not turn on.	Battery is dead or incorrectly inserted.	Replace battery or check polarity.
Trimmer pulls hair instead of cutting.	Blades are dull or clogged with hair.	Clean the trimming head thoroughly. If problem persists, blades may need replacement (contact support).
Reduced cutting performance.	Low battery power or dirty blades.	Replace battery. Clean the trimming head.
