## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before using this appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury to persons, or exposure to excessive microwave energy.

## **General Safety Precautions:**

- Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open or if the door is damaged.
- Do not place any object between the oven front face and the door, or allow soil or cleaner residue to accumulate on sealing surfaces.
- Do not operate the oven if it is damaged, especially the door, hinges, or seals.
- Only qualified service personnel should adjust or repair this appliance.
- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers as they are liable to explode.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance.
- Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not use this appliance for commercial purposes other than its intended use.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Winco EMW-1000SD is a commercial-grade microwave oven designed for demanding foodservice environments. It features a durable stainless steel construction, a user-friendly dial control system, and efficient heating capabilities.

# **Key Features:**

- .9 Cubic Foot Capacity: Accommodates up to a 12-inch platter, suitable for quick-serve restaurants and concession stands.
- Commercial-Grade Construction: Durable stainless steel interior and exterior designed for daily commercial use.
- **Bottom Antenna:** Motor-driven antenna ensures efficient energy distribution and even heating without a turntable.
- Dial Operation: Simple and intuitive rotary dials for adjusting power levels and cooking time.
- Power Output: 1000 Watts for efficient cooking.
- LED Display: Clear LED backlight display for time and power settings.

## 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

## **Unpacking:**

- 1. Carefully remove the microwave oven from its packaging.
- 2. Inspect the oven for any signs of damage. Do not operate if damaged.
- 3. Remove all packing materials, including any protective film or tape from the interior and exterior surfaces.
- 4. Ensure all accessories, such as the instruction manual, are present.

#### **Placement:**

Place the oven on a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface capable of supporting its weight (approximately 41 pounds).

- Ensure adequate ventilation around the oven. Maintain a minimum clearance of 4 inches (10 cm) from the rear and sides, and 12 inches (30 cm) from the top.
- Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Keep the oven away from heat sources, strong magnetic fields, and areas with high humidity.

## **Electrical Connection:**

- Connect the oven to a dedicated 120V~60Hz, 12A grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not use extension cords or adapter plugs.
- Ensure the electrical circuit can handle the 1000W power requirement.

# 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Winco EMW-1000SD features intuitive dial controls for easy operation.

# **Basic Cooking:**

1. **Place Food:** Open the oven door and place the food in a microwave-safe container directly onto the ceramic base. Close the door securely.

- 2. **Select Power Level:** Rotate the upper dial (labeled "POWER LEVEL") to select the desired power setting. Options typically include 100%, 80%, 50%, 40%, and Defrost.
- 3. **Set Cooking Time:** Rotate the lower dial (labeled "TIME") to set the desired cooking duration. The LED display will show the selected time.
- 4. **Start Cooking:** Press the lower dial (PUSH START/STOP) to begin cooking. The oven light will illuminate, and the cooking process will start.
- 5. **Stop/Pause:** To pause cooking, press the lower dial once. To resume, press it again. To stop cooking completely and clear the settings, open the door or press and hold the lower dial.
- 6. End of Cycle: The oven will beep when the cooking cycle is complete.

## **Defrosting:**

- Place frozen food in the oven.
- Rotate the "POWER LEVEL" dial to the "DEFROST" setting.
- Set the desired defrosting time using the "TIME" dial.
- Press the "TIME" dial to start. Monitor food closely and turn or separate items as needed for even defrosting.

**Note:** This microwave does not have a rotating turntable. For best results, stir or rotate food manually during longer cooking times to ensure even heating.

## 5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Winco microwave oven.

## **Cleaning the Exterior:**

· Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent.

- For stainless steel, use a specialized stainless steel cleaner and polish in the direction of the grain to prevent streaks.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.

## **Cleaning the Interior:**

- After each use, wipe the interior with a soft, damp cloth to remove food splatters.
- For stubborn food residue, place a bowl of water with a few lemon slices inside the oven and heat on high for 2-3 minutes. The steam will loosen the residue, making it easier to wipe clean.
- Clean the door seals and surrounding areas regularly to ensure a proper seal.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or spray water directly into the oven.

#### **General Care:**

- Always unplug the oven before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Ensure the oven is completely dry before plugging it back in and using it.
- Do not attempt to repair or modify the oven yourself. Refer to qualified service personnel for any repairs.

# 6. TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

If you encounter issues with your microwave oven, consult the following table before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not start	<ul> <li>Power cord not securely plugged in.</li> <li>Door not closed properly.</li> <li>Circuit breaker tripped or fuse blown.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure power cord is firmly plugged into a grounded outlet.</li> <li>Close the door firmly until it latches.</li> <li>Check your household circuit breaker or fuse box.</li> </ul>
Food not heating evenly	<ul> <li>Food not stirred or rotated.</li> <li>Incorrect power level or cooking time.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Stir or rotate food halfway through cooking.</li> <li>Adjust power level and cooking time as needed.</li> </ul>
Oven light not working	Bulb burned out.	Contact qualified service personnel for bulb replacement.
Excessive noise during operation	<ul><li>Loose components.</li><li>Improper placement.</li></ul>	<ul><li>Ensure the oven is on a stable, level surface.</li><li>If noise persists, contact service.</li></ul>
