1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Comforday Handheld Steam Cleaner. This multi-purpose steamer is designed to provide powerful, chemical-free cleaning for a wide range of surfaces in your home and vehicle. With its quick heating and versatile accessories, you can effectively tackle grease, mold, grout, and various stains, ensuring a clean and hygienic environment.

Key features include:

- **Quick Hot Steam:** Delivers pressurized steam (105°C) up to 15 minutes with 1050W power.
- **Chemical-Free Cleaning:** Utilizes only water for cleaning, making it 100% chemical-free and safe for various surfaces.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Equipped with a safety lock on the handle and a safety cap for user protection.
- **9-Piece Accessory Kit:** Includes a comprehensive set of attachments for diverse cleaning tasks.
- **Multi-Surface Versatility:** Suitable for ceramic, laminate, marble, hardwood floors, sinks, stoves, countertops, windows, toilets, tiles, upholstery, car seats, and more.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always ensure the safety lock on the handle is engaged when not actively steaming to prevent accidental steam release.
- The safety cap is designed to prevent opening while the unit is pressurized. If the safety cap is hard to open, wait a few minutes for the steam to cool down. Only open the safety cap when the power is off and the unit has cooled to avoid scalding.
- Do not overfill the water tank. Overfilling can lead to hot water spraying from the nozzle during use.
- For optimal performance and to prevent mineral buildup (scaling), it is recommended to use distilled water.
- Never point the steam nozzle at people, pets, or electrical appliances. Steam is extremely hot and can cause severe burns.
- Always unplug the steam cleaner from the power outlet before filling, emptying, or cleaning the unit, and

before attaching or removing accessories.

- Do not leave the appliance unattended while it is plugged in or operating.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not immerse the steam cleaner in water or any other liquid.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS AND ACCESSORIES

Your Comforday Handheld Steam Cleaner comes with a comprehensive 9-piece accessory kit to enhance its versatility for various cleaning tasks:

- **Extended Nozzle:** For reaching tight spaces and directing steam precisely.
- **Spray Cup with Brush:** Ideal for scrubbing stubborn dirt and grime on surfaces like grout and tiles.
- **Bent Spray:** Perfect for cleaning hard-to-reach areas such as toilet rims and curved surfaces.
- **Funnel:** Assists in safely pouring water into the steam cleaner's tank.
- **Measuring Cup:** Ensures accurate water measurement for optimal performance.
- **Spray Cup for Door & Window:** Designed for streak-free cleaning of glass and smooth surfaces.
- **Towel Sleeve:** Used with the brush plate for cleaning and refreshing fabrics and upholstery.
- **Brush Plate:** Base attachment for the towel sleeve, suitable for larger flat surfaces.
- **Long Spray Cup:** Provides extended reach for targeted steam application.

4. SETUP AND FILLING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to prepare your steam cleaner for use:

1. Ensure the steam cleaner is unplugged from the power outlet.
2. Twist the safety cap counter-clockwise to remove it. If the unit was recently used, allow it to cool down completely before attempting to open the cap.
3. Using the provided measuring cup and funnel, carefully pour up to 250ml (8.5 oz) of clean water into the water tank. It is highly recommended to use distilled water to prevent mineral buildup and prolong the life of your appliance. Do not overfill.
4. Replace the safety cap by twisting it clockwise until it is securely tightened.
5. Attach the desired accessory to the nozzle by aligning it and twisting or pushing until it clicks into place.
6. Plug the steam cleaner into a standard 120V electrical outlet. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the unit is heating up.

7. Allow approximately 2-4 minutes for the water to heat and steam to build pressure. The indicator light may turn off once ready, or it may remain on depending on the model.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the steam cleaner is heated and ready, you can begin cleaning:

1. Hold the steam cleaner firmly by the handle.
2. Press and hold the steam trigger to release steam. Ensure the safety lock is disengaged before pressing the trigger.
3. Direct the steam nozzle towards the surface you wish to clean. For best results, hold the nozzle close to the surface (within 1-2 inches).
4. Move the steam cleaner slowly over the area, allowing the hot steam to penetrate and loosen dirt and grime.
5. Use the appropriate accessory for the task:
 - **Spray Cup with Brush:** Excellent for scrubbing stubborn stains on grout, tiles, and oven grates.
 - **Bent Spray:** Ideal for cleaning hard-to-reach corners, toilet bowls, and faucets.
 - **Spray Cup for Door & Window:** Use with a squeegee motion for windows, mirrors, and other glass surfaces.
 - **Towel Sleeve with Brush Plate:** For refreshing and cleaning fabrics, upholstery, and mattresses.
 - **Long Spray Cup/Extended Nozzle:** For precise steam application in tight crevices or for reaching higher areas.
6. Wipe the steamed area with a clean cloth to remove loosened dirt and moisture.
7. When finished, release the steam trigger, engage the safety lock, and unplug the unit. Allow it to cool down before storing.

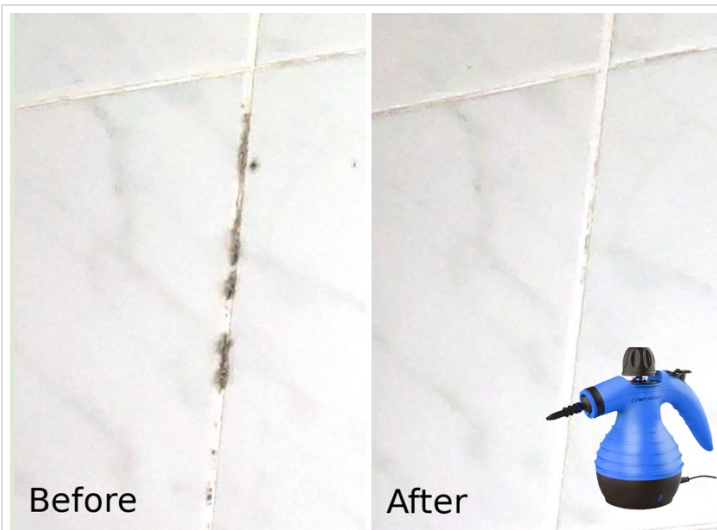

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your steam cleaner:

- **Emptying the Water Tank:** After each use, ensure the unit is unplugged and completely cooled. Carefully open the safety cap and pour out any remaining water.
- **Descaling:** If you use tap water, mineral deposits can build up over time. To descale, fill the tank with a solution of equal parts white vinegar and distilled water. Let it sit for 30 minutes (do not heat). Empty the solution and rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water. Perform this monthly or as needed based on water hardness.
- **Cleaning Accessories:** Wash accessories with mild soap and water. Ensure they are completely dry before

storing.

- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the steam cleaner with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the steam cleaner and its accessories in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Comforday Handheld Steam Cleaner, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Steam is not hot or strong enough.	Unit not fully heated; steam released too early; distance from surface too far; mineral buildup.	Allow sufficient time for the unit to heat up (2-4 minutes). Ensure the steam temperature reaches 95°C-105°C before use. Hold the nozzle closer to the surface for best effect. Descale the unit if necessary (refer to Maintenance section).
Safety cap is difficult to open.	Unit is still pressurized or hot.	Unplug the unit and allow it to cool down completely before attempting to open the safety cap. Never force the cap open.
Hot water sprays from the nozzle instead of steam.	Water tank is overfilled.	Ensure you do not exceed the maximum fill line (250ml) when adding water. Empty excess water if overfilled.
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; internal fault.	Check if the unit is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet. If the issue persists, contact customer support.



