1. Introduction

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Einhell TE-VC 18 LI Solo Cordless Handheld Vacuum Cleaner. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following safety precautions to prevent electric shock, fire, or injury:

- Ensure the vacuum cleaner is used only for its intended purpose as described in this manual.
- Do not vacuum liquids, hot ashes, flammable or explosive substances, or sharp objects.
- · Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- · Do not operate the vacuum cleaner without the dust collector and filter properly installed.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Use only Einhell Power X-Change batteries and chargers.
- Disconnect the battery pack before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing the appliance.
- Store the appliance indoors in a dry place.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The Einhell TE-VC 18 LI Solo is a versatile cordless handheld vacuum cleaner designed for various cleaning tasks. It is part of the Einhell Power X-Change family, meaning it uses the same 18V battery system as other Einhell tools.

3.1 Included Accessories

- Extension tube
- · Crevice nozzle
- · Upholstery nozzle
- Floor nozzle

Note: The Einhell TE-VC 18 LI Solo is supplied without a battery or charger. These must be purchased separately as part of the Einhell Power X-Change system.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

4.1 Attaching the Battery

- 1. Ensure the battery is fully charged using a compatible Einhell Power X-Change charger.
- 2. Align the battery pack with the battery slot on the vacuum cleaner handle.
- 3. Slide the battery into the slot until it clicks securely into place.
- 4. To remove the battery, press the release button on the battery pack and slide it out.

4.2 Attaching Accessories

Select the appropriate nozzle or extension tube for your cleaning task. Simply push the desired accessory firmly onto the suction opening of the vacuum cleaner until it is securely attached.

• Crevice Nozzle: Ideal for narrow gaps and corners.

- Upholstery Nozzle: Suitable for cleaning fabric surfaces.
- Floor Nozzle with Extension Tube: For upright vacuuming of larger floor areas.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Switching On/Off

- To switch on the vacuum cleaner, press the ON/OFF switch located on the handle.
- To switch off, press the ON/OFF switch again.

5.2 General Use

Guide the vacuum cleaner over the surface to be cleaned. The powerful suction will collect dust and debris into the collection container. For larger areas or floor cleaning, attach the extension tube and floor nozzle.

5.3 Battery Runtime

The operating time of the vacuum cleaner depends on the capacity of the Power X-Change battery used. Refer to the chart below for estimated runtimes:




Figure 5.2: Estimated maximum running times for various Einhell Power X-Change battery capacities (e.g., 2.0 AH for 16 min, 4.0 AH for 31 min, 6.0 AH for 46 min).

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner.

6.1 Emptying the Dust Collection Container

- 1. Ensure the vacuum cleaner is switched off and the battery is removed.
- 2. Locate the release button for the dust collection container (refer to Figure 3.2).
- 3. Press the button to detach the container from the main unit.
- 4. Empty the contents into a waste bin. The container has a capacity of 540 ml.
- 5. Reattach the container securely until it clicks into place.

6.2 Cleaning the Filter

- 1. After emptying the dust container, remove the filter element.
- 2. Tap the filter gently to dislodge dust. For a more thorough cleaning, rinse the filter under running water.
- 3. Allow the filter to air dry completely before reinserting it into the dust container. Do not use the vacuum cleaner with a wet filter.
- 4. Reassemble the filter and dust container, then attach them back to the vacuum cleaner.

6.3 Storage

Store the vacuum cleaner and its accessories in a dry, secure place, out of reach of children. The unit can be stored compactly using a wall bracket.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not switch on.	Battery not inserted correctly or discharged.	Ensure battery is securely inserted. Charge the battery if necessary.
Low suction power.	Dust collection container full, filter clogged, or nozzle/hose blocked.	Empty dust container. Clean or replace filter. Check nozzles and hose for blockages.
Unusual noise during operation.	Foreign object in the suction path or motor issue.	Switch off and remove battery. Check for and remove any foreign objects. If noise persists, contact customer support.
