### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Ivation Foot Spa Massager. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always unplug the unit before filling or emptying the basin.
- Do not use the unit while sleeping or with loose clothing that could get caught in the rollers.
- Keep the unit and power cord away from water to prevent electrical shock.
- Do not use if you have a heart condition, high blood pressure, or any other medical condition that could be affected by heat or massage. Consult a doctor before use if you are pregnant or have any other health concerns.
- Never leave the unit unattended while in use.
- Always follow the temperature guidelines to prevent burns.
- Always use the unit on a flat, stable surface.

### SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to prepare your foot spa for use:

1. Place the unit on a flat, stable surface. Ensure the surface is dry and clear of obstacles.
2. Fill the spa with water. Refer to the minimum and maximum water level indicators marked inside the basin. Do not overfill.
3. Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Basic Operation

1. Press the Power button to turn on the unit. The digital display will illuminate.
2. Use the Temperature Up (▲) and Down (▼) buttons to select your desired water temperature. The water can be heated up to 122°F (50°C).
3. Press the Timer button to set the duration of your foot spa session.
4. Choose from various functions such as Bubble, Vibration, and Massage Rollers by pressing their respective buttons on the control panel.
5. Place your feet into the water and enjoy the selected features.
6. After use, press the Power button to turn off the unit and unplug it from the outlet. Carefully empty the water.

## Heat, Bubble, or Massage Options

### Features and Functions

- **Heated Water:** The foot spa maintains your desired water temperature up to 122°F (50°C) for a consistently warm and relaxing experience.
- **Oxygenating Bubbles:** Multiple water jets generate thousands of calming bubbles to help relieve pressure and pain.
- **Vibration Massage:** An invigorating vibration feature encourages circulation and soothes weary feet.
- **Automatic Shiatsu Massage Rollers:** Activate the motorized rollers to target tense and tired soles, providing a deep tissue massage.
- **Pedicure Attachments:** The unit includes three interchangeable pedicure attachments (brush, acupressure, and pumice stone) for comprehensive foot care.




Image: The massage rollers provide targeted acupressure to the soles of your feet.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your foot spa.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, unplug the unit and empty the water. Rinse the basin with clean water. Use a mild soap and a soft cloth to clean the interior and exterior surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Drying:** Thoroughly dry the unit before storing. Ensure no water remains in the basin or around the electrical components.
- **Storage:** Store the foot spa in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keep the power cord neatly coiled to prevent damage.
- **Pedicure Attachments:** Clean the pedicure attachments with soap and water after each use and allow them to air dry completely before storing.

## TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

---

If you encounter any issues with your Ivation Foot Spa, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in; Power outlet malfunction; Unit malfunction.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Test the outlet with another appliance. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Water is not heating.	Heating function not activated; Temperature setting too low; Unit malfunction.	Ensure the heat function is activated on the control panel. Increase the temperature setting. Allow sufficient time for the water to heat. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Bubbles or vibration not working.	Function not activated; Obstruction in jets/motor.	Ensure the bubble or vibration function is activated. Check for any debris blocking the bubble jets or affecting the vibration mechanism. Clean the unit thoroughly.
Massage rollers are not moving.	Massage function not activated; Obstruction.	Ensure the massage function is activated. Check for any foreign objects obstructing the rollers.
