INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the REDMOND RMC-M4515E Digital Smart Multicooker. This appliance is designed to simplify your cooking process with its versatile functions and automatic programs. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure safe and efficient operation.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury.

- Do not immerse the main unit in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the voltage rating matches your power supply.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not operate if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Always use the non-stick bowl provided.
- Avoid touching hot surfaces during and immediately after operation.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the appliance.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The REDMOND RMC-M4515E Multicooker includes the following main components:

- Main unit with control panel and LED display
- Removable 4-liter non-stick cooking bowl
- Removable steam valve
- Power cord

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials. Retain the packaging for future transport or storage.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the removable cooking bowl, steam valve, and any accessories with warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the multicooker on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.
4. **Power Connection:** Ensure the multicooker is switched off before plugging it into a grounded electrical outlet (220-230V).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel Overview

The control panel features an LED digital display and touch controls for various functions and programs.

Automatic Programs

The RMC-M4515E offers 6 automatic programs for various cooking needs:

- **FRY:** For frying ingredients.
- **PILAF:** Specifically designed for cooking pilaf.
- **PORRIDGE/GRAIN:** Ideal for cooking porridges and various grains.
- **BAKE/PIZZA:** For baking cakes, bread, or pizzas.
- **STEW/DESSERT:** Suitable for stewing dishes and preparing desserts.
- **STEAM/SOUP:** For steaming vegetables, fish, or preparing soups.

General Cooking Steps

1. Place the non-stick cooking bowl into the main unit.

2. Add your ingredients to the bowl.
3. Close the lid securely.
4. Plug the multicooker into a power outlet.
5. Select the desired automatic program by pressing the corresponding button.
6. Adjust the cooking time if necessary using the "COOK TIME" button.
7. Press the "START/CANCEL" button to begin cooking.
8. Once cooking is complete, the multicooker may automatically switch to the "KEEP WARM" function.
9. Press "START/CANCEL" to stop the program or turn off the appliance.

Special Functions

- **KEEP WARM:** Automatically activates after most programs, keeping food warm for up to 24 hours.
- **REHEAT:** Allows reheating food for up to 24 hours.
- **TIME DELAY:** Set a delayed start time for cooking, up to 24 hours.
- **ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS:** This multicooker supports making fondue, baking bread, making cheese and cottage cheese, preparing baby food, pasteurizing, sterilizing, and food preservation. Refer to specific recipes or the REDMOND recipe book for detailed instructions on these functions.

Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your multicooker.

1. **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Cooking Bowl:** Wash the non-stick cooking bowl with warm soapy water and a soft sponge. Do not use abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads, as this can damage the non-stick coating. The bowl is **not** dishwasher safe.
3. **Steam Valve:** Remove the steam valve and wash it under running water. Ensure it is clear of any food residue.
4. **Lid and Interior:** Wipe the inside of the lid and the interior of the main unit with a damp cloth. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
5. **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the multicooker with a soft, damp cloth.
6. **Storage:** Store the multicooker in a dry place, away from direct sunlight, once it is clean and dry.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Multicooker does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; faulty outlet.	Check power cord connection; verify power supply; try a different outlet.
Food not cooking properly.	Incorrect program selected; insufficient cooking time; lid not properly closed.	Ensure correct program and time are set; check lid seal.
Steam leaking from lid.	Lid not closed correctly; steam valve blocked or improperly installed.	Close lid firmly; clean and re-install steam valve.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Non-stick coating damaged.	Use of abrasive utensils or cleaners.	Always use non-abrasive utensils (wood, silicone, plastic) and soft sponges for cleaning.
