# Candy CMXW22DS Microwave Oven User Manual

Your comprehensive guide to operating and maintaining your Candy CMXW22DS solo microwave oven.

## 1. SETUP

### 1.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the microwave oven from its packaging. Inspect the appliance for any signs of damage. Retain the packaging materials for future transport or storage if needed.

### 1.2 Placement

Place the microwave oven on a flat, stable surface capable of supporting its weight. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit. Maintain a minimum clearance of 20 cm on the left side (where the ventilation is located) and above the unit, and 10 cm at the rear and right side for proper airflow. Do not block any ventilation openings.

### 1.3 Electrical Connection

Before plugging in the appliance, ensure that the voltage indicated on the rating plate matches your local power supply. Connect the microwave oven to a properly grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

## 2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 2.1 Control Panel Overview

### 2.2 Basic Operation

To start cooking, place food in a microwave-safe container on the turntable. Close the door firmly. Use the rotary knob to set the desired cooking time and power level. Press the Start button to begin. The microwave features a "Start Express" function, allowing you to set the oven to maximum power for 30 seconds with a single button press.

### 2.3 Automatic Programs

The Candy CMXW22DS offers 40 automatic programs for various food types. Select the desired program using the control panel, and the microwave will automatically adjust cooking time and power. Consult the program list in your manual for detailed instructions on each program.

### 2.4 Defrost Function

The automatic defrost program allows you to defrost food by weight or time. Select the defrost function, input the weight of the food or the desired defrosting time, and the microwave will manage the process for optimal results.

### 2.5 Silence Function (Sound Off)

To operate the microwave quietly, activate the "Sound Off" function. This feature mutes operational beeps and alerts, providing a more peaceful cooking experience.

## 2.6 Safety Lock (Child Lock)

Activate the "Safety Lock" function to prevent accidental operation, especially by children. This feature disables the control panel, ensuring maximum safety in the kitchen.

## 3. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your microwave oven.

### 3.1 Interior Cleaning (Masterclean Cavity)

The Masterclean cavity is designed with a smoother internal surface to facilitate cleaning. After each use, wipe the interior with a damp cloth and mild detergent to remove food splatters and grease. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and heat for a few minutes to create steam, then wipe clean.

### 3.2 Exterior Cleaning

Clean the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the finish. Ensure the ventilation openings are free from dust and debris.

### 3.3 Turntable Care

The glass turntable and roller ring can be removed for cleaning. Wash them in warm, soapy water or in a dishwasher. Ensure they are completely dry before placing them back in the microwave.

## 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your microwave oven, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Microwave does not start:**

- Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the outlet.
- Ensure the door is fully closed.
- Check your household fuse/circuit breaker.
- Deactivate the Safety Lock function if it is engaged.

- **Food is not heating:**

- Verify that the cooking time and power level are set correctly.
- Ensure the turntable is properly placed and rotating.
- Check if the food container is microwave-safe.

- **Unusual noise during operation:**

- Ensure the turntable and roller ring are correctly positioned.
- Check for any foreign objects inside the cavity.

- **Display is dim or off (ECO function):**

- The ECO function may be active, turning off LEDs to save energy. This is normal operation.



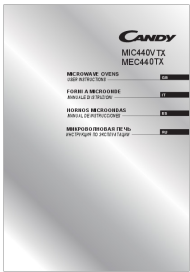

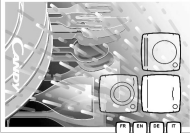
