INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing Gobrico 22 Inch Rear/Side Mount Drawer Slides. These ball bearing, soft-close, full-extension drawer glides are designed for heavy-duty use, providing smooth and quiet operation for your drawers. This manual provides essential information for installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your drawer slides.

PRODUCT FEATURES

The Gobrico drawer slides are engineered with several key features to enhance functionality and durability:

- **Full Extension Opening:** Allows for the entire drawer to be accessed, maximizing storage space and convenience.
- **Hydraulic Soft/Self Close Feature:** Ensures drawers close slowly and quietly without slamming shut, protecting contents and reducing noise.
- **Ball Bearing Mechanism:** Utilizes double rows of solid steel balls for smooth, silent movement and labor-saving pulling/pushing.
- **Heavy Duty Construction:** Made from work-hardened cold rolled steel with a zinc-plated finish, providing a load capacity of 78 pounds (35 KG).
- **Versatile Mounting:** Designed for both side and rear mount applications with included brackets.
- **Lever Disconnect:** Features a lever disconnect for easy drawer removal and reinstallation.

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Proper installation is crucial for the optimal performance of your drawer slides. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Separate the Slides:** Fully extend the drawer slide and press the black release lever to separate the inner slide member from the main body. The inner slide member attaches to the drawer box, and the main body attaches to the cabinet.
2. **Attach to Drawer Box:** Align the inner slide member with the bottom edge of your drawer box. Ensure it is level and flush with the front of the drawer. Use the provided screws to secure it firmly to the side of the drawer box. Repeat for the other side of the drawer.

3. **Attach to Cabinet:** Determine the desired height for your drawer within the cabinet. Attach the main body of the slide to the inside of the cabinet wall. Use the included brackets for rear mounting if applicable, ensuring they are squared and securely fastened. For side mounting, ensure the slide is level and parallel to the cabinet opening.
4. **Insert Drawer:** Carefully align the drawer box (with the inner slide members attached) with the main slide bodies in the cabinet. Gently push the drawer in until you feel the slides engage. Push firmly to ensure the soft-close mechanism is properly seated.
5. **Test Operation:** Open and close the drawer several times to ensure smooth operation and proper soft-closing. If the drawer does not slide smoothly or close correctly, check for alignment issues. Loosen screws slightly, adjust, and re-tighten.

OPERATION

Operating your Gobrico drawer slides is straightforward:

- **Opening:** Pull the drawer handle to open. The full extension design allows the drawer to come out completely, providing easy access to all contents.
- **Closing:** Push the drawer gently to close. The hydraulic soft-close mechanism will engage when the drawer is pushed to a certain point, slowly and quietly pulling it shut.
- **Removing Drawer:** To remove the drawer from the cabinet, fully extend it and locate the black release levers on both slides (one on each side). Press down on one lever and lift up on the other simultaneously, then pull the drawer straight out.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the long-term smooth operation of your Gobrigo drawer slides, consider the following maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe down the slide rails with a clean, dry cloth to remove dust and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Lubrication:** If the slides begin to feel stiff or less smooth over time, a light application of silicone spray lubricant on the ball bearings can restore optimal performance. Do not use oil-based lubricants as they can attract dust.
- **Check Fasteners:** Occasionally check all mounting screws to ensure they are tight. Loose screws can affect slide performance and lead to misalignment.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your drawer slides, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawer does not slide smoothly or feels stiff.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accumulated dust or debris. Lack of lubrication. Misalignment of slides. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clean the slide rails with a dry cloth. Apply a light coat of silicone spray lubricant to the ball bearings. Check that both slides are parallel and level. Adjust mounting screws as needed.
Drawer does not close completely or soft-close feature is not engaging.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Misalignment of slides or brackets. Obstruction preventing full closure. Soft-close spring mechanism issue (less common). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure slides and rear brackets are perfectly square and level. Loosen screws, adjust, and re-tighten. Check for any items or debris blocking the drawer's path. If springs are loose or damaged, contact customer support for replacement.
Drawer is difficult to open or close.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Overloaded drawer (exceeding weight capacity). Tight installation. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reduce the weight in the drawer. Ensure slides are not overtightened during installation. A slight adjustment might be needed.
