INTRODUCTION

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety information before assembling or using this product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 265 pounds (120 kg) per stool.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten fasteners as needed.
- **Stability:** Place the stools on a flat, level, and stable surface to prevent tipping.
- **Children:** Keep children away from the assembly area. Small parts can be a choking hazard.
- **Movement:** Do not stand on the footrest or arms. Do not use the stool as a step ladder.
- **Outdoor Use:** While designed for outdoor use, prolonged exposure to extreme weather conditions may affect the product's lifespan. Consider covering or storing the stools during harsh weather.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer service.

- Bar Stool Frame Components (e.g., seat frame, backrest, legs, footrest bars)
- Wicker Rattan Panels (pre-attached to frame components)
- Assembly Hardware (screws, washers, nuts, Allen wrench)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly typically requires two people for easier alignment and stability. Follow these general steps for assembling each bar stool.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent

scratches.

2. **Attach Backrest to Seat:** Connect the backrest to the seat frame using the provided screws and washers. Do not fully tighten yet.
3. **Assemble Legs:** Attach the legs to the seat frame. Ensure the legs are oriented correctly. Secure with screws and washers, but do not fully tighten.
4. **Install Footrest:** Connect the footrest bars between the legs. This step is crucial for structural integrity and stability. Align the holes and insert the screws.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are loosely assembled, place the stool on a flat surface. Gradually tighten all screws and bolts evenly. Ensure the stool is stable and does not wobble. If wobbling occurs, loosen screws slightly, adjust the stool on a flat surface, and then re-tighten.

OPERATING AND USAGE

These bar stools are designed for comfortable seating in various environments.

- **Placement:** Suitable for patios, gardens, poolsides, lawns, backyards, or indoor study areas.
- **Footrest:** Utilize the integrated footrest for added comfort and support.
- **Weight Limit:** Adhere strictly to the 265-pound (120 kg) weight limit per stool.
- **Surface:** Best used on hard, flat surfaces to maintain stability.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your bar stools.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the wicker rattan and steel frame with a soft cloth dampened with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely to prevent water spots or rust. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Weather Protection:** Although the wicker is designed to be weather-resistant, protecting the stools from prolonged direct sunlight, heavy rain, snow, and extreme temperatures will help preserve their condition. Consider using furniture covers or storing them indoors during off-seasons or severe weather.

- **Fastener Check:** Periodically inspect all screws and bolts for tightness. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity and prevent wobbling.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stool wobbles after assembly	Uneven tightening of fasteners; uneven floor surface; misaligned parts.	Place the stool on a flat surface. Loosen all screws slightly, apply even pressure to the seat, then re-tighten all screws firmly. Ensure the floor surface is level.
Missing or damaged parts	Packaging error; transit damage.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Tangkula customer service immediately for replacement parts.
Chemical odor from product	New product off-gassing.	Place the stools in a well-ventilated area for several days to allow the odor to dissipate.
