1. INTRODUCTION

2. SETUP GUIDE

2.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all items listed below are present:

- Dell Optiplex Desktop Tower
- 17-inch LCD Monitor (brand may vary)
- Keyboard
- Mouse
- Wi-Fi Adapter
- Power Cables
- Video Cable (VGA or DVI, depending on model)

2.2 Connecting Components

Follow these steps to connect your computer system:

1. **Connect the Monitor:** Connect the video cable from the monitor to the corresponding port on the back of the desktop tower. Ensure a secure connection.
2. **Connect the Keyboard:** Plug the keyboard's USB cable into an available USB port on the back or front of the desktop tower.
3. **Connect the Mouse:** Plug the mouse's USB cable into an available USB port on the back or front of the desktop tower.
4. **Connect the Wi-Fi Adapter:** Insert the USB Wi-Fi adapter into an available USB port. Drivers may install automatically; if not, follow on-screen prompts or refer to the adapter's instructions.
5. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cable into the desktop tower's power input, then plug the other end into a wall outlet or surge protector. Do the same for the monitor.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Powering On

Once all components are connected, press the power button located on the front of the desktop tower. The monitor should display the Dell logo, followed by the Windows 10 loading screen.

3.2 Operating System

Your Dell Optiplex comes pre-installed with Microsoft Windows 10. Follow the on-screen prompts for initial setup, including setting up user accounts and connecting to a Wi-Fi network.

3.3 Basic Usage

Utilize the keyboard for typing and the mouse for navigation within the Windows 10 environment. The Wi-Fi adapter allows for wireless internet access. For optical media, insert DVDs into the DVD drive on the front of the tower.

Regularly update your Windows 10 operating system and device drivers. This ensures optimal performance, security, and compatibility. You can check for updates via Windows Update in your system settings.

4.3 Ventilation

Ensure the desktop tower is placed in a well-ventilated area. Do not block the air vents on the front, back, or sides of the tower, as this can lead to overheating and performance issues.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Computer does not power on.	Loose power cable, faulty outlet.	Ensure all power cables are securely connected. Try a different power outlet.
No display on monitor.	Monitor not powered on, loose video cable, incorrect input source.	Check monitor power. Verify video cable is firmly connected to both monitor and tower. Press the monitor's input source button to select the correct input.
Keyboard or mouse not responding.	Loose USB connection, faulty device.	Reconnect the USB cable to a different USB port. Restart the computer.
No internet connection (Wi-Fi).	Wi-Fi adapter issues, router problem, incorrect Wi-Fi settings.	Ensure Wi-Fi adapter is properly installed. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Check Wi-Fi settings in Windows 10.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Computer is slow or unresponsive.	Too many programs running, low disk space, malware.	Close unnecessary programs. Free up disk space. Run a full system scan with antivirus software.
