Introduction

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Handle with care: This carafe is made of glass and can break if dropped or subjected to sudden temperature changes.
- Avoid extreme temperature changes: Do not place a hot carafe on a cold surface or pour cold liquids into a hot carafe, as this may cause breakage.

SETUP

- 1. Unpack the carafe carefully from its packaging.
- 2. Wash the carafe and its lid thoroughly with warm, soapy water before first use. Rinse completely.
- 3. Ensure the carafe is completely dry before placing it on the coffee maker's warming plate.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This carafe is designed as a direct replacement for your original Mr. Coffee 10- or 12-cup carafe. Its operation is integrated with your existing coffee maker.

- 1. Place the clean, empty carafe onto the warming plate of your compatible Mr. Coffee coffee maker.
- 2. Ensure the carafe is properly seated to activate the drip-stop mechanism (if your coffee maker has one).
- 3. Brew coffee according to your coffee maker's instructions. The carafe will collect the brewed coffee.
- 4. The pour-away handle is designed to stay cool, allowing for safe handling and pouring of hot coffee. The drip-free spout minimizes spills.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your replacement carafe.

- **Dishwasher Safe:** The carafe is dishwasher safe for convenient cleaning. Place on the top rack for best results.
- **Hand Washing:** For optimal care, especially for the lid and handle, hand washing with warm, soapy water is recommended. Use a soft sponge or cloth to avoid scratching the glass.
- Stain Removal: For coffee stains, a mixture of baking soda and water or a specialized coffee cleaner can be used. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning.
- Drying: Allow the carafe to air dry completely or dry with a soft, lint-free cloth.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Carafe does not fit coffee maker.	Incorrect model compatibility.	Verify your coffee maker model against the list of compatible models (EJX, LMX, VMX, ISX, FTX, TJX series). This carafe is specifically designed for these Mr. Coffee series.
Carafe leaks when pouring.	Lid not properly seated or damaged spout.	Ensure the lid is securely placed on the carafe. Inspect the spout for any chips or cracks that might affect pouring.
Glass appears cloudy or stained.	Mineral deposits or coffee residue.	Clean thoroughly with warm, soapy water. For stubborn stains, use a mixture of baking soda and water or a commercial coffee cleaner.
