INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of this radiator valve should be performed by a qualified professional to ensure correct function and prevent leaks. Incorrect installation can lead to system damage or personal injury.

1. **System Preparation:** Ensure the heating system is depressurized and drained before beginning installation.
2. **Valve Orientation:** Determine whether an angle or straight-through connection is required for your radiator. The universal design accommodates both.
3. **Thermostatic Head Adjustment:** The thermostatic valve head can be rotated to either the right or left side for optimal access and aesthetic integration. Adjust this before final tightening.
4. **Connection:** Connect the valve to the radiator and the heating pipes using appropriate sealing materials. The valve features a standard 50 mm connection.
5. **Tightening:** Secure all connections firmly but avoid over-tightening, which can damage threads or seals.
6. **System Refill and Test:** After installation, refill the heating system, bleed air from the radiator, and check all connections for leaks.

Refer to your radiator and heating system manuals for specific connection requirements and safety guidelines.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Buderus Logafix Universal Radiator Valve allows you to control the heat output of your radiator, contributing to energy efficiency and comfort.

- **Temperature Control:** Rotate the thermostatic head to adjust the desired room temperature. Higher numbers or symbols typically indicate warmer settings.
- **Frost Protection:** Most thermostatic valves include a frost protection setting (often marked with an asterisk or snowflake symbol). This setting maintains a minimum temperature to prevent pipes from freezing.
- **Full Open/Closed:** The valve can be fully opened for maximum heat or fully closed to shut off heat to the radiator.

Allow time for the room temperature to stabilize after adjusting the valve setting.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficient operation of your radiator valve.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the chrome surface with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents, which can damage the finish.
- **Valve Movement:** Periodically (e.g., once a year before the heating season), turn the thermostatic head through its full range of motion several times. This helps prevent the valve pin from sticking, especially if the valve has been in one position for an extended period.
- **Leak Inspection:** Regularly check connections for any signs of water leaks. Address any leaks immediately by tightening connections or replacing seals if necessary.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Radiator not heating up.	Valve is closed or stuck. Air in the radiator.	Turn the thermostatic head to a higher setting. Rotate the head through its full range of motion. Bleed the radiator.
Radiator is too hot, even on low setting.	Valve not closing completely.	Ensure the thermostatic head is correctly seated. Rotate the head through its full range of motion to free the valve pin. If problem persists, professional inspection may be needed.
Water leak at connections.	Loose connection or faulty seal.	Depressurize the system. Carefully tighten the connection. If leak persists, replace the seal or contact a professional.
