## INTRODUCTION

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Solution
Laptop does not power on.	Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected and the power outlet is functional. Check if the battery is charged. Try a hard reset by holding the power button for 15-20 seconds.
Slow performance.	Close unnecessary applications. Check for background processes using Task Manager. Ensure sufficient free space on the hard drive. Run a disk cleanup.
Wi-Fi connectivity issues.	Restart your router and modem. Disable and re-enable Wi-Fi on the laptop. Update Wi-Fi drivers. Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi network.
Overheating.	Ensure vents are clear of obstructions. Use the laptop on a hard, flat surface. Consider using a cooling pad. Reduce heavy workload if possible.
