Shot Navi W1-GL Golf GPS User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Shot Navi W1-GL Golf GPS watch. This device is designed to enhance your golf experience by providing accurate distance measurements and course information directly on your wrist. It comes pre-loaded with over 30,000 golf courses globally, eliminating the need for additional fees or downloads for course updates.

Key features include:

- Pre-loaded access to over 30,000 golf courses worldwide.
- Accurate distance readings to the front, center, and back of the green, as well as to hazards.
- Functionality to calculate shot distances during your round.
- Long-lasting battery life: up to 8 hours in GPS mode and 4 weeks in watch mode.
- No membership or download fees required for course data.

SETUP

1. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the device. Connect the charging cable to the watch and a compatible USB power source. The battery indicator on the display will show charging status. A full charge ensures optimal performance during your golf round.

2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the 'MODE' button until the display illuminates.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the 'MODE' button until the power-off confirmation appears, then confirm.

3. GPS Acquisition

Once powered on, the device will automatically attempt to acquire a GPS signal. For best results, ensure you are outdoors with a clear view of the sky. This process may take a few moments. Upon successful acquisition, the device will display available golf courses in your vicinity.

4. Course Selection

Use the 'UP' and 'DOWN' buttons to navigate through the list of detected courses. Press the 'OK/MARK' button to select your desired course. The device will then load the course data and display the first hole information.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Golf Mode Display

In Golf Mode, the display typically shows:

- Current Hole Number and Par.
- Distances to the Front (F), Center (C), and Back (B) of the green.
- Distances to various hazards (e.g., bunkers, water).
- Battery level indicator.

2. Navigating Holes

The device automatically advances to the next hole as you move. If manual adjustment is needed, use the 'UP' and 'DOWN' buttons to change holes.

3. Shot Distance Measurement

To measure the distance of your shot:

1. At your starting position, press the 'OK/MARK' button to mark the spot.
2. Walk to where your ball landed. The display will show the distance from your marked starting point.
3. Press 'OK/MARK' again to clear the measurement and mark a new starting point for the next shot.

4. Watch Mode

To switch to Watch Mode, press the 'MODE' button. In Watch Mode, the device functions as a standard digital watch, conserving battery life. To return to Golf Mode, press 'MODE' again.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

Wipe the device regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the screen and casing. Ensure the charging port is clean and dry before connecting the charger.

2. Battery Care

The Shot Navi W1-GL uses a Lithium Ion battery. To prolong battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not fully discharge the battery frequently.
- Store the device with a partial charge (around 50%) if not used for extended periods.

3. Storage

Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Device Not Powering On

Ensure the device is fully charged. If the issue persists, try connecting it to a different USB power source or charging cable.

2. GPS Signal Not Acquired

Ensure you are outdoors with a clear view of the sky, away from tall buildings or dense foliage that might obstruct the signal. Wait a few minutes for the device to acquire satellites. If the problem continues, try restarting the device.

3. Incorrect Distances Displayed

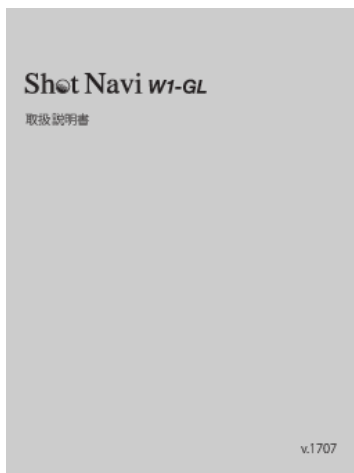
Verify that the correct golf course has been selected. Ensure the device has a strong GPS signal. Course data updates are automatically managed by Shot Navi, but if you suspect an issue with a specific course, check the manufacturer's website for any known issues or updates.

4. Short Battery Life

Ensure the device is fully charged before use. Using GPS mode continuously will consume battery faster than Watch Mode. Reduce screen brightness if possible. If battery life significantly degrades, contact support.
