## INTRODUCTION

## SETUP

### Initial Activation

If your watch display is blank or shows an incorrect time upon arrival, it may be in a power-saving mode or require initial setup. Some watches come with a plastic tab in the crown/button to prevent battery drain; remove this tab if present.

### Setting Time and Date

1. Press the **MODE** button repeatedly until the time setting mode is displayed (often indicated by flashing digits).
2. Use the **SET** or **START/STOP** button to adjust the flashing digit (hours, minutes, seconds).
3. Press **MODE** again to move to the next setting (e.g., minutes, then year, month, day).
4. Once all settings are correct, press **MODE** to exit the setting mode and return to normal time display.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Using the Alarm

1. Press **MODE** until the alarm time is displayed.
2. Press **SET** to enter alarm setting mode. Adjust hours and minutes using **START/STOP**.
3. Press **MODE** to save and exit.
4. To activate/deactivate the alarm, press **SET** in alarm display mode. An alarm icon will appear/disappear.

### Using the Stopwatch

1. Press **MODE** until the stopwatch function is displayed (usually 00:00:00).
2. Press **START/STOP** to start the stopwatch.
3. Press **START/STOP** again to pause/resume.
4. Press **LIGHT/RESET** to reset the stopwatch to zero.

### Using the Countdown Timer

1. Press **MODE** until the countdown timer function is displayed.

2. Press **SET** to enter timer setting mode. Adjust hours, minutes, and seconds using **START/STOP**.
3. Press **MODE** to save and exit setting mode.
4. Press **START/STOP** to begin the countdown.
5. The watch will beep when the timer reaches zero.

## Dual Time Function

Your watch can display a second time zone. To set and view dual time:

1. Press **MODE** until the dual time display is shown.
2. Press **SET** to enter dual time setting mode. Adjust hours and minutes using **START/STOP**.
3. Press **MODE** to save and exit.

## Using the Backlight

Press the **LIGHT/RESET** button to illuminate the display for a few seconds, improving visibility in low-light conditions.

## MAINTENANCE

### Water Resistance

Your Dakota Digital Mini Clip Watch is water resistant to 100 feet (3 ATM). This means it is protected against accidental

splashes, rain, and brief immersion. It is **not** designed for swimming, diving, or prolonged water exposure. **Do not press any buttons while the watch is submerged in water**, as this can compromise the water seal.

## Battery Replacement

The watch requires 1 Lithium Metal battery (included). When the display becomes dim or the watch stops functioning, it's time to replace the battery. Battery replacement should ideally be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure the water resistance seal is maintained.

## Cleaning

Clean your watch regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the finish or display.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Display is blank:** Check if the battery tab has been removed. If not, the battery may need replacement.
- **Time is incorrect:** Follow the "Setting Time and Date" instructions to reset the time.
- **Buttons not responding:** Ensure the watch is not in a locked mode (if applicable, though not specified for this model). If the issue persists, a battery replacement or professional inspection may be needed.
- **Alarm not sounding:** Verify that the alarm is activated (alarm icon visible) and the volume is not muted (if applicable).
