SETUP

1. **Unpack the Filter:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any damage.

- 2. **Assemble the Filter:** Ensure the filter cartridge is correctly seated within the filter housing. The Aqua-Flow 300 features a dual-action filter cartridge.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Superfish Aqua-Flow 300 is designed for continuous operation. Once plugged in, the filter will begin to draw water through its intake and return filtered water to the aquarium.

- Flow Rate: The filter has a flow rate of 540 L/H, suitable for maintaining water quality in smaller aquariums.
- Water Level: Always ensure the water level in your aquarium is above the minimum water line indicated on the filter to prevent dry running.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the optimal performance and longevity of your Aqua-Flow 300 filter. The easy-clean system simplifies this process.

- 1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the filter from the power outlet before performing any maintenance.
- 2. Remove Filter: Carefully remove the filter unit from the aquarium.
- 3. Clean/Replace Cartridge: The dual-action filter cartridge should be rinsed regularly in old aquarium water (not tap water, as chlorine can kill beneficial bacteria) or replaced as needed. The frequency depends on the aquarium's bioload, but typically every 2-4 weeks.
- 4. **Clean Impeller:** Periodically remove the impeller and clean it and its housing to prevent blockages and maintain efficient water flow.
- 5. **Reassemble and Reinstall:** After cleaning, reassemble the filter components and place the filter back into the aquarium, ensuring it is fully submerged before plugging it back in.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Filter not running	No power; Impeller jammed; Air lock	Check power connection; Clean impeller; Gently shake filter to release air
Reduced water flow	Clogged filter cartridge; Dirty impeller	Clean or replace filter cartridge; Clean impeller
Noisy operation	Air in filter; Impeller not seated correctly; Worn impeller	Gently shake filter; Re-seat impeller; Replace impeller if worn
