## 1. INTRODUCTION AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Thank you for choosing the Solac Optima 2600W Steam Iron. This manual provides essential information for safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

### Important Safety Instructions:

- Always unplug the iron from the electrical outlet when filling with water, emptying, or when not in use.
- Do not immerse the iron, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Use the iron only for its intended use.
- Never direct steam at people or pets.
- The iron must be used and rested on a stable surface.
- Do not leave the iron unattended while it is connected or on an ironing board.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND FEATURES

The Solac Optima 2600W Steam Iron is designed for efficient and comfortable ironing, featuring advanced technologies for durability and performance.

### Key Features:

- **Easy Drive Ceramic Soleplate:** Provides smooth gliding on all fabrics and offers greater scratch resistance for long-lasting performance.
- **Vertical Steam Function:** Allows for wrinkle removal from hanging garments, curtains, and delicate items, and can also help eliminate odors.
- **Large 380ml Water Tank:** Ensures extended ironing sessions without frequent refills, enhancing ironing autonomy.

- **Self-Cleaning System:** Contributes to the iron's longevity by preventing mineral buildup.
- **Anti-Drip System:** Prevents water stains on fabrics, even at low temperatures.
- **Anti-Calc System:** Reduces limescale buildup, maintaining steam performance over time.
- **Ergonomic Design:** Features a soft-touch handle for comfortable grip and ease of use.
- **2600W Power:** Ensures rapid heating and powerful steam output of 170 g/min.

## 3. SETUP AND FIRST USE

### Before First Use:

1. Remove any labels or protective film from the soleplate.
2. It is normal for a small amount of smoke or odor to be produced during the first few minutes of use. This will disappear after a short time.
3. For the first use, iron an old piece of fabric to ensure any manufacturing residues are removed.

### Filling the Water Tank:

1. Ensure the iron is unplugged from the power outlet.
2. Open the water inlet cover, usually located at the front of the iron's handle.
3. Using a measuring cup, carefully pour clean tap water into the tank up to the 'MAX' fill line. Do not overfill.
4. Close the water inlet cover securely.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Temperature Setting:

1. Plug the iron into a suitable electrical outlet.
2. Turn the temperature control dial to the desired setting based on the fabric type. Start with lower temperatures for delicate fabrics and increase for heavier ones.
3. The indicator light will illuminate, indicating the iron is heating up. It will turn off when the set temperature is reached.

### Steam Ironing:

1. Ensure the water tank is filled.
2. Set the temperature to a steam-appropriate setting (usually indicated on the dial with steam symbols). Steam will only be produced at higher temperatures.
3. Once the indicator light turns off, indicating the iron is hot enough, activate the steam function using the steam control button or slider.
4. Move the iron smoothly over the fabric.

### **Vertical Steam:**

1. Hang the garment on a hanger.
2. Fill the water tank and set the iron to its maximum temperature.
3. Hold the iron vertically, a few centimeters away from the fabric, and press the steam burst button repeatedly.
4. This function is ideal for curtains, suits, and delicate items that cannot be ironed flat.

### **Dry Ironing:**

For dry ironing, ensure the water tank is empty or the steam control is set to the 'no steam' position. Set the desired temperature and iron as usual.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Solac iron.

### Cleaning the Soleplate:

- After use, allow the iron to cool completely.
- Wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive cleaner if necessary.
- Do not use abrasive pads, scouring powders, or harsh chemicals as they can damage the ceramic coating.

### Self-Cleaning Function:

The self-cleaning function helps remove impurities from the steam chamber. Perform this function regularly, especially if you notice reduced steam output or white flakes.

1. Fill the water tank to the MAX level.
2. Set the iron to its maximum temperature and allow it to heat up until the indicator light turns off.
3. Unplug the iron.
4. Hold the iron horizontally over a sink.
5. Press and hold the self-clean button (usually labeled 'CALC CLEAN') until all the water has drained from the tank, carrying impurities with it.
6. Release the button and allow the iron to cool down.

### Anti-Calc System:

The integrated anti-calc system reduces limescale buildup. While it minimizes maintenance, regular self-cleaning is still recommended.

### Storage:

- Always empty the water tank after each use to prevent limescale buildup and leakage.
- Allow the iron to cool completely before storing.
- Store the iron upright on its heel rest to protect the soleplate.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iron, please consult the following table before contacting customer service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet faulty; temperature dial set to MIN.	Check power connection; try another outlet; set temperature dial to desired heat.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or insufficient steam.	Water tank empty; temperature too low for steam; steam vents clogged.	Fill water tank; set to higher temperature (steam setting); perform self-cleaning.
Water leaks from soleplate.	Temperature too low for steam (anti-drip system not active); water tank overfilled.	Increase temperature to steam setting; do not overfill water tank.
White flakes coming from soleplate.	Limescale buildup.	Perform self-cleaning function.
