1. INTRODUCTION TO COCHON RAPIDO

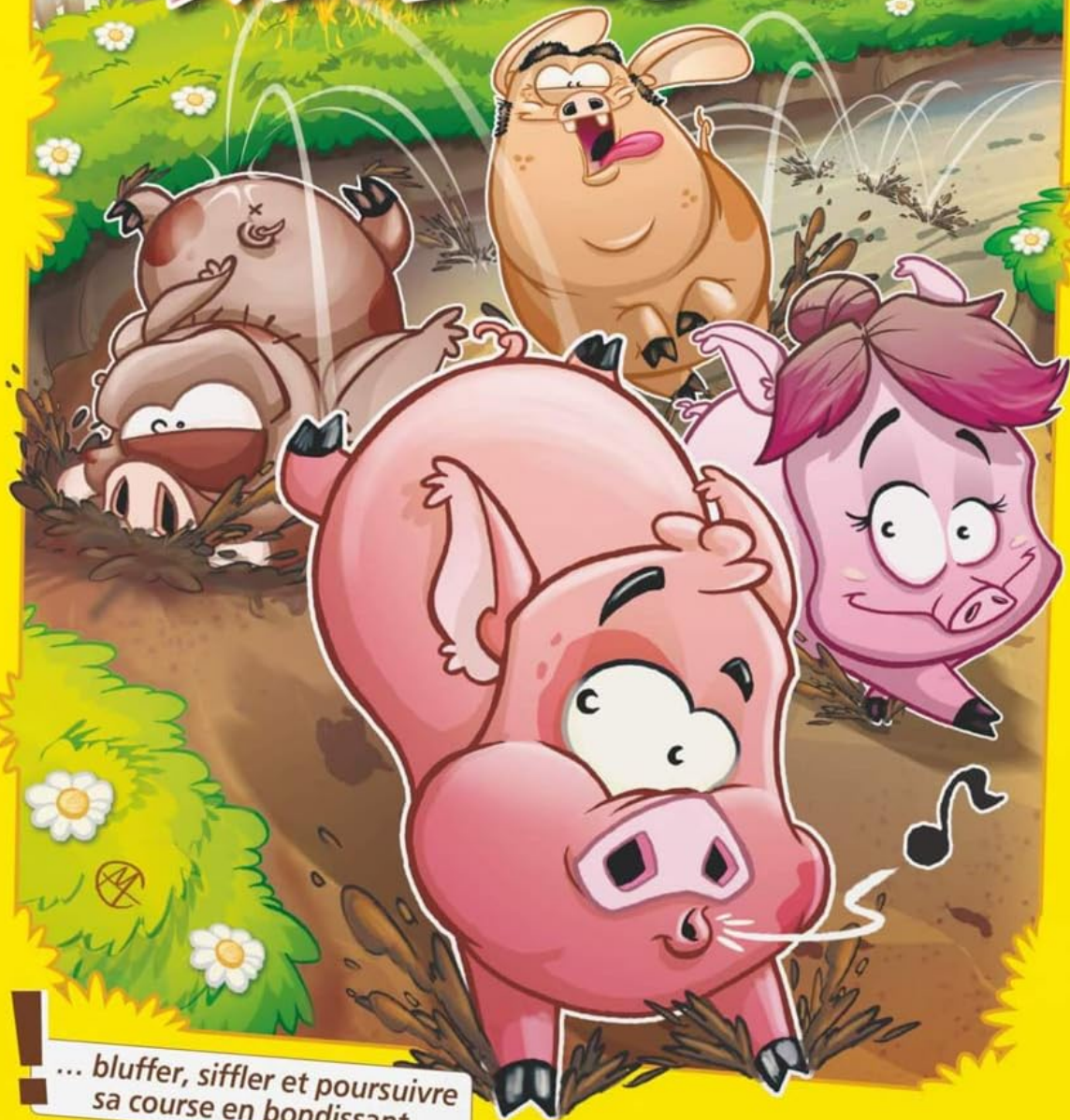
Cochon Rapido is an engaging board game by HABA, designed for 2 to 4 players aged 5 to 99 years. The game involves a playful race where pigs compete to collect apples. Players use strategy and a bit of luck to make their pigs whistle or jump at the right moment to secure the most apples.

The objective of the game is to be the player who successfully collects the most apples by skillfully maneuvering your pig and anticipating your opponents' moves.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

- Not suitable for children under 3 years due to small parts. Choking hazard.
- Recommended for ages 5 and up.
- Adult supervision is advised for younger players.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Carefully unpack the game and ensure all components listed below are present:

- 1 x Game Board (composed of 3 interlocking pieces)
- 4 x Wooden Pig Figures
- 6 x Race Cards
- 16 x Apple Tiles
- 1 x Rulebook (this document)

4. SETUP

1. **Assemble the Game Board:** Connect the 3 game board pieces to form the complete race track. Place it in the center of the playing area.
2. **Place Apple Tiles:** Distribute the 16 apple tiles face down onto the designated spaces on the game board.
3. **Prepare Pig Figures:** Each player chooses a wooden pig figure and places it at the starting line of the race track.
4. **Shuffle Race Cards:** Shuffle the 6 race cards thoroughly and place them face down in a draw pile next to the game board.
5. **Determine First Player:** The youngest player typically starts, or players can decide on another method.

5. OPERATING (GAME RULES)

The game is played in rounds, with players taking turns. On your turn, follow these steps:

1. **Draw a Race Card:** Draw the top card from the race card pile. This card will indicate a number of spaces your pig can move

or a special action.

- 2. **Move Your Pig:** Move your pig figure forward along the track according to the number shown on the card. If the card indicates a special action (e.g., "whistle" or "jump"), perform that action as described on the card. These actions might allow you to collect apples or affect other players' pigs.
- 3. **Collect Apples:** If your pig lands on a space with an apple tile, you may choose to collect it. Flip the tile over to reveal the apple. Keep collected apples face up in front of you.
- 4. **Bluffing and Strategy:** The game encourages players to observe opponents and use bluffing tactics. Sometimes, it's strategic to pretend to move in a certain way or to hold back an action to surprise other players.
- 5. **End of Turn:** After moving and potentially collecting an apple, your turn ends. Play passes to the next player in clockwise order.

Game End and Scoring:

The game ends when all apple tiles have been collected or when a predetermined number of rounds have passed (e.g., when the race card pile runs out). Players then count their collected apples. The player with the most apples wins the game.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe game components with a dry, soft cloth if they become dusty. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store all game components in their original box in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent warping or damage.
- **Handling:** Handle wooden and cardboard components with care to ensure their longevity.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Missing Components:** If any components are missing upon opening the box, please contact HABA customer support with proof of purchase.
- **Rule Clarification:** If there are any ambiguities in the rules, refer to the official HABA website or contact their customer service for clarification.

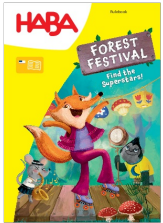
