1. Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your STANLEY Solid Brass Miniature Medium Hinge. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning installation to ensure safe and efficient use of the product. This hinge is designed for various light-duty applications requiring a durable and compact brass hinge.

2. Safety Information

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as safety glasses, during installation.
- Keep small parts, such as screws, out of reach of children to prevent choking hazards.
- Ensure the mounting surface is stable and capable of supporting the hinge and any attached components.
- Use only the recommended tools and fasteners for installation.
- Do not overtighten screws, as this may strip the material or damage the hinge.

3. Package Contents

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation.

- Mounting Screws (appropriate for hinge size, typically included)

4. Setup and Installation

Tools Required: Pencil, Screwdriver (appropriate size for screws), Drill (optional, for pilot holes), Measuring Tape.

1. **Prepare the Surface:** Identify the exact location where the hinge will be mounted on both the door/panel and the frame/surface. Ensure the surfaces are clean and flat.
2. **Mark Pilot Holes:** Position one leaf of the hinge on the desired mounting surface. Use a pencil to mark the locations for the screw holes. Repeat this for the second leaf on the opposing surface.
3. **Drill Pilot Holes (Optional but Recommended):** For softer woods or to prevent splitting, drill small pilot holes at the marked locations. Ensure the drill bit is slightly smaller than the screw diameter.
4. **Attach First Leaf:** Align the first hinge leaf with the marked pilot holes and secure it using the provided screws. Do not fully tighten all screws until both leaves are loosely attached.
5. **Attach Second Leaf:** Align the second hinge leaf with its marked pilot holes on the opposing surface. Ensure the hinge is properly aligned and operates smoothly before securing it with screws.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once both leaves are in place and the hinge operates correctly, fully tighten all screws. Avoid overtightening.

5. Operation

The STANLEY Solid Brass Miniature Medium Hinge is designed for smooth, consistent operation. Once installed, the hinge allows for the rotational movement of the attached door or panel. Ensure that the hinge is not subjected to forces beyond its intended capacity, which could lead to damage or premature wear.

6. Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the hinges with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and grime. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Lubrication:** If the hinge begins to squeak or stiffen, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the pin and knuckles. Wipe away any excess lubricant.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check the screws for tightness. If any screws are loose, gently tighten them. Inspect the hinge for any signs of wear, damage, or corrosion.

7. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hinge squeaks	Lack of lubrication, dust/debris in pin.	Apply a silicone-based lubricant to the hinge pin and knuckles. Clean any visible debris.
Hinge feels loose	Loose mounting screws.	Gently tighten all mounting screws. Do not overtighten.
Door/panel sags or misaligns	Improper installation, loose screws, damaged hinge.	Check all mounting screws for tightness. Re-evaluate hinge alignment. If hinge is damaged, replace it.
