INTRODUCTION

The Gamevice GV150 controller provides a classic control experience for your Apple iPad. It is designed to transform your iPad into a portable gaming console, offering precise and tactile controls for an enhanced gaming experience. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Gamevice GV150 controller.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Gamevice GV150 controller features a flexible bridge design that securely attaches to your compatible iPad, providing a full set of gaming controls. It is compatible with Apple iPad (9.7" iPad Pro/iPad/iPad Air 2).

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Gamevice GV150 controller with your iPad:

1. **Prepare your iPad:** Ensure your Apple iPad (9.7" iPad Pro/iPad/iPad Air 2) is clean and free of any bulky cases that might obstruct the connection.
2. **Attach the Controller:** Gently expand the flexible bridge of the Gamevice controller. Align the iPad's Lightning port with the controller's Lightning connector on the right module. Carefully slide the iPad into place, ensuring both the left and right modules securely grip the iPad. The controller does not require Bluetooth pairing; it connects directly via the Lightning port.
3. **Verify Connection:** Once attached, your iPad should recognize the controller. You can now launch compatible games.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the Gamevice GV150 is attached to your iPad, it functions as a standard MFi (Made for iPhone/iPad) game controller.

Gaming:

- **Control Layout:** Utilize the dual analog joysticks for movement and camera control, the D-pad for directional input, and the A-B-X-Y face buttons for actions. The L1/R1 shoulder buttons and L2/R2 analog triggers provide additional input options.
- **Game Compatibility:** For a comprehensive list of games compatible with the Gamevice controller, download and refer to the optional Gamevice Live app available on iTunes.

Charging your iPad:

The Gamevice GV150 features a pass-through Lightning port, allowing you to charge your iPad without detaching the controller.

- **Connect Charger:** Plug a standard Lightning charging cable into the Lightning port located on the right module of the Gamevice controller.
- **Power Indication:** Your iPad will indicate that it is charging.

Audio Output:

For private listening or connecting external audio devices, use the integrated 3.5 mm headphone jack.

- **Connect Headphones:** Plug your 3.5 mm headphones or audio cable into the headphone jack on the right module of the controller.
- **Audio Routing:** Audio from your iPad will be routed through the controller's headphone jack.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity of your Gamevice GV150 controller.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe down the controller. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the surface.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the controller in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keep it free from dust and debris.
- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the controller or subjecting it to strong impacts. Do not force the iPad into or out of the controller, as this may damage the Lightning connector or the flexible bridge.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Gamevice GV150 controller, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Controller Not Responding:**
 - Ensure your iPad is securely and correctly seated in the Gamevice controller, making full contact with the Lightning connector.
 - Restart your iPad and reattach the controller.
- **iPad Not Charging (Pass-Through):**
 - Verify that the Lightning charging cable is fully inserted into the controller's Lightning port and connected to a working power source.
 - Test the charging cable and power source with another device to ensure they are functional.
- **No Audio from Headphone Jack:**
 - Ensure your headphones are fully plugged into the 3.5 mm jack on the controller.
 - Check your iPad's volume settings.
 - Test your headphones with another device to confirm they are working correctly.

• **Game Compatibility Issues:**

- Not all games support MFi controllers. Consult the Gamevice Live app or the game's description on iTunes to confirm controller support.
- Ensure your game and iPad operating system are updated to the latest versions.
