INTRODUCTION

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your PILOT G2 Mechanical Pencil package includes:

- 5 x PILOT G2 Mechanical Pencils (0.7mm)
- Extra 0.7mm HB Lead Refills
- Extra Eraser Refills

SETUP AND REFILLING

1. Loading Lead

1. Remove the eraser cap from the top of the pencil.
2. Gently insert new 0.7mm lead refills into the opening where the eraser was located. Do not force the lead.
3. Insert 2-3 pieces of lead at a time to prevent jamming.
4. Replace the eraser cap firmly.

2. Replacing the Eraser

1. Pull the used eraser straight out from the top of the pencil.
2. Insert a new eraser refill into the opening.
3. Push the new eraser in firmly until it is securely seated.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Extending the Lead

- To extend the lead, simply click the top button of the pencil repeatedly until the desired lead length is exposed.

2. Retracting the Lead

- To retract the lead, press and hold the top button, then gently push the lead back into the pencil tip with your finger.

3. Erasing

- Use the white eraser located at the top of the pencil to correct mistakes.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the pencil with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust or smudges.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the pencil's finish.

Storage

- Store your mechanical pencils in a pencil case or drawer to protect them from damage and prevent lead breakage.
- Keep away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Lead Not Advancing

- **Check Lead Supply:** Ensure there is sufficient lead inside the pencil. Refill if necessary.
- **Clear Jam:** If lead is present but not advancing, gently remove the tip assembly and check for any jammed lead fragments. Use a thin wire or the end of another lead to carefully dislodge any obstructions.

Lead Breaking Frequently

- **Reduce Pressure:** Apply less pressure when writing. Mechanical pencil lead is designed to be strong but can break under excessive force.
- **Check Lead Length:** Avoid extending too much lead at once. A shorter exposed lead length is less prone to breaking.
- **Lead Quality:** Ensure you are using high-quality 0.7mm HB lead refills.
