1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your new Hauck Batmobile Pedal Go Kart. This manual provides essential information for safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your ride-on vehicle. Please read all instructions carefully before use to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety when operating the go-kart. Adult supervision is required at all times.

- **Age Range:** Suitable for children aged 4 to 8 years.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum user weight of 77 pounds (35 kg).
- **Supervision:** Always ensure an adult supervises the child during operation.
- **Protective Gear:** Always wear a helmet and appropriate safety gear (e.g., knee and elbow pads) when riding.
- **Operating Environment:** Use on flat, smooth surfaces away from traffic, steep inclines, stairs, and water.
- **Braking:** Familiarize the child with the handbrake for effective speed control and stopping.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly inspect the go-kart for loose parts, damage, or wear before each use.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Hauck Batmobile Pedal Go Kart requires assembly. All necessary bolts and hardware are included. A cross-head and flat-head screwdriver may be needed in addition to the provided tools.

Assembly Steps:

1. Remove all components from the packaging.
2. Assemble the go-kart frame according to the detailed instructions provided in the separate assembly guide.
3. Attach the wheels, steering column, and seat using the included bolts and hardware.
4. Adjust the bucket seat to fit the child's leg length comfortably. Ensure the child can reach the pedals and steer easily.
5. Verify all connections are secure and all moving parts operate smoothly before first use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This pedal go-kart is designed for manual operation, allowing the child to control speed and direction.

Basic Operation:

- **Pedaling:** The go-kart is propelled by race-styled pedals. Push forward with feet to move forward, and backward to reverse.
- **Steering:** Use the steering wheel to control the direction of the front wheels.
- **Braking:** The go-kart features an easy-to-use handbrake that works on both rear wheels. Pull the handbrake lever to slow down or stop the vehicle.
- **Adjustable Seat:** The bucket seat can be adjusted to accommodate the child's growth, ensuring comfortable and proper leg extension for pedaling.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your go-kart.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the go-kart with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts, nuts, and connections to ensure they are tight. Inspect wheels and pedals for wear or damage.
- **Lubrication:** Apply a small amount of lubricant to moving parts like the chain and pedal mechanism if they become stiff.
- **Storage:** Store the go-kart in a dry, covered area to protect it from weather elements.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your go-kart, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty pedaling	Chain or pedal mechanism is stiff; seat not adjusted correctly.	Lubricate moving parts; adjust the seat to ensure proper leg extension.
Loose front fender	Clips may have disengaged due to impact or vibration.	Re-engage the clips to snap the front fender back into place. If clips are broken, contact customer support.
Go-kart pulls to one side	Steering mechanism misalignment or uneven tire pressure.	Check for obstructions in the steering mechanism. Ensure wheels are properly aligned and secured.
