1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Tchibo Cafissimo Mini capsule coffee machine. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to the appliance:

• Read all instructions before operating the appliance.

- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not operate the appliance if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Use only original Tchibo Cafissimo capsules with this machine.
- Exercise caution when handling hot liquids and steam.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning and when not in use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Tchibo Cafissimo Mini is a compact and fully automatic capsule coffee machine designed for ease of use. It features a unique pressure system to prepare various coffee types and tea.

Key Components:

- Water Tank: Removable, 650 ml capacity.
- Control Panel: Buttons for different beverage types.
- Capsule Holder: For inserting Tchibo Cafissimo capsules.
- Coffee Spout: Removable for easy cleaning.
- Drip Tray: Collects excess liquid, removable for cleaning.
- Used Capsule Container: Integrated, holds up to 4 used capsules.
- Cup Stand: Adjustable for various cup heights (up to 13 cm).

4. SETUP

4.1 Unpacking

- 1. Remove all packaging materials from the machine.
- 2. Place the machine on a stable, level surface.

4.2 Initial Cleaning

- 1. Remove the water tank, drip tray, and used capsule container.
- 2. Wash these parts with warm water and a mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
- 3. Wipe the exterior of the machine with a damp cloth.
- 4. Reassemble all parts.

4.3 Filling the Water Tank

- 1. Remove the water tank from the back of the machine.
- 2. Fill the tank with fresh, cold drinking water up to the MAX mark.
- 3. Place the water tank back onto the machine securely.

4.4 First Use / Priming

- 1. Plug the machine into a grounded power outlet.
- 2. Place an empty cup under the coffee spout.
- 3. Press any beverage button. The machine will start a priming cycle, pumping water through the system.
- 4. Repeat this process 2-3 times until water flows smoothly. This cleans the internal system and prepares it for use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Tchibo Cafissimo Mini offers three pressure levels for different beverages: espresso, Caffè Crema, and filter coffee/tea.

5.1 Preparing a Beverage

- 1. Ensure the water tank is filled and the machine is plugged in.
- 2. Open the capsule holder lever.
- 3. Insert one Tchibo Cafissimo capsule into the holder. Close the lever firmly.
- 4. Place a cup (up to 13 cm high) on the cup stand under the coffee spout.
- 5. Select your desired beverage by pressing the corresponding button:
 - Espresso: For a strong, concentrated coffee.
 - Caffè Crema: For a milder coffee with a fine crema.
 - Filter Coffee / Tea: For a classic filter coffee or tea.
- 6. The machine will automatically brew the beverage and stop when finished.
- 7. After brewing, open the capsule holder lever to eject the used capsule into the integrated container. Close the lever.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance ensure optimal performance and longevity of your machine.

6.1 Daily Cleaning

- 1. **Empty Used Capsule Container:** After each use or when full (holds up to 4 capsules), remove and empty the container. Rinse with water.
- 2. **Clean Drip Tray:** Remove the drip tray and empty any collected liquid. Wash with warm water and mild detergent.
- 3. Clean Coffee Spout: The coffee spout is removable for thorough cleaning. Rinse it under running water.
- 4. Wipe the exterior of the machine with a soft, damp cloth.

6.2 Descaling

Descaling is crucial to remove mineral deposits and maintain brewing quality. The frequency depends on water hardness and usage. Refer to the full instruction manual for detailed descaling procedures, typically involving a descaling solution and specific machine cycles.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Tchibo Cafissimo Mini, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not turn on.	No power supply.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the machine and the outlet. Check the fuse.
No water flow.	Water tank empty; machine not primed; air in the system.	Fill the water tank. Perform the priming process (Section 4.4).
Coffee is cold or not brewing properly.	Machine not preheated; descaling needed.	Allow the machine to preheat. Perform descaling (Section 6.2).
Water leaks from the machine.	Water tank not correctly seated; drip tray full.	Ensure the water tank is securely in place. Empty the drip tray.
