1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before installing or using the Star HB-198065 Quartz Heater Element. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, property damage, or personal injury. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Electrical Hazard:** Always disconnect power to the heater unit before attempting any installation, maintenance, or replacement of the heating element. Ensure the power source matches the element's specifications (120V).
- **Heat Hazard:** The quartz element generates high temperatures. Allow the element and surrounding components to cool completely before handling. Do not touch the element when it is hot or connected to power.
- Proper Installation: This element is designed for specific heater models. Ensure compatibility before
 installation. Incorrect installation can lead to malfunction or fire. If unsure, consult a qualified electrician or
 service technician.
- Flammable Materials: Keep all flammable materials (furniture, curtains, paper, clothing) at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) away from the heater unit where this element will be installed.
- **Indoor Use Only:** This element is intended for indoor use within a compatible heater unit. Do not use outdoors or in wet locations.
- Children and Pets: Keep children and pets away from the heater unit during operation and maintenance.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Star HB-198065 is a replacement quartz heating element designed for compatible electric radiant heaters. It operates at 120V and provides 800W of heat output. This element is crucial for the radiant heating function of your appliance.

3. Installation Instructions

- 6. Reassemble Heater: Replace the outer casing or grille, ensuring all fasteners are tightened.
- 7. **Test:** Plug the heater unit back into the electrical outlet and test its operation. Observe for proper heating and any unusual sounds or smells.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (FOR THE HEATER UNIT)

Once the Star HB-198065 Quartz Heater Element is correctly installed in your compatible heater unit, follow these general operating guidelines for the heater:

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your heater unit is not functioning correctly after installing the Star HB-198065 Quartz Heater Element, refer to the following common issues:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Heater does not turn on.	No power to the unit. Loose electrical connection. Heater's internal safety switch tripped.	Check if the heater is plugged in securely. Verify the wall outlet is functional. Ensure all element connections are tight. Unplug the heater, wait 10 minutes, and plug it back in.	
Element does not heat up.	Faulty element (unlikely if new). Incorrect wiring. Heater's thermostat or switch malfunction.	Re-check element wiring as per installation instructions. If the element is confirmed to be new and correctly installed, the issue may lie with other heater components. Consult a technician.	
Partial heating or uneven heat.	One or more elements not functioning (if heater has multiple). Dust accumulation affecting heat distribution.	Inspect all elements if applicable. Clean the heater's grilles and interior as per maintenance section.	

For issues not listed here or if troubleshooting steps do not resolve the problem, contact the manufacturer or a qualified service technician.
