1. INTRODUCTION

The Plantronics Voyager 5200 Wireless Bluetooth Headset is engineered for clear, uninterrupted communication in diverse environments. Featuring advanced noise-cancelling technology and WindSmart protection, this headset ensures your voice is heard clearly, even amidst wind, chatter, and traffic. Designed for all-day comfort and seamless integration with your mobile devices, the Voyager 5200 is an ideal solution for professionals on the go.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Features:

- **Cutting-Edge Noise Cancelling:** Equipped with four microphones and proprietary DSP to effectively block disruptive background noise.
- **Exclusive WindSmart Technology:** Six layers of technology detect wind direction and adapt for clear voice transmission, especially outdoors.
- **HD Voice Clarity:** Enhances speech quality over wideband networks for superior call clarity.
- **All-Day Comfort:** Ergonomically designed and rigorously tested for stability and comfort across various ear shapes.
- **Extended Talk Time:** Up to 7 hours of continuous talk time on a single charge, with up to 9 days in standby mode.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Headset:

Before first use, fully charge your Plantronics Voyager 5200 headset. Connect the Micro USB charging cable to the headset's charging port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). A full charge takes approximately 7 hours. The LED indicator on the headset will show charging status.

4.2 Pairing with Your Device:

1. Ensure your headset is charged and powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power button on the headset until the LED flashes red and blue, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your smartphone or other Bluetooth-enabled device, navigate to the Bluetooth settings.
4. Select "Plantronics V5200" (or similar) from the list of available devices.
5. Once connected, the headset LED will stop flashing and remain solid blue. A voice prompt will confirm the connection.

The headset supports Bluetooth 4.1 and has a wireless range of up to 10 meters (approximately 33 feet).

4.3 Fitting the Headset:

The Voyager 5200 is designed for comfortable wear. Gently place the earpiece over your ear, ensuring the microphone boom extends towards your mouth. Adjust the earpiece for a secure and comfortable fit. The headset can be worn on either the left or right ear by rotating the microphone boom.

5. OPERATING THE HEADSET

5.1 Power On/Off:

- To Power On: Slide the Power switch to the 'On' position.
- To Power Off: Slide the Power switch to the 'Off' position.

5.2 Making and Receiving Calls:

- **Answer Call:** Tap the Call button.
- **End Call:** Tap the Call button.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Call button for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-tap the Call button.

5.3 Volume Control:

Use the Volume Up (+) and Volume Down (-) buttons located on the headset to adjust the listening volume during calls or media playback.

5.4 Voice Commands and Smart Features:

The Plantronics Voyager 5200 supports voice control for enhanced convenience. Depending on your connected device, you can activate voice assistants like Siri through touch controls on the headset. Refer to your device's manual for specific voice assistant activation and commands.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning Your Headset:

Regularly clean your headset to maintain optimal performance and hygiene. Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the surfaces. For the eartip, gently remove it and clean with a damp cloth, ensuring it is completely dry before reattaching. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

6.2 Storage:

When not in use, store the headset in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight. Protect it from dust and moisture.

6.3 Battery Care:

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the headset frequently. Recharge the headset when the low battery indicator appears. If storing for an extended period, charge the headset at least once every six months.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No audio or poor audio quality	Headset not paired; out of range; low battery; microphone blocked.	Ensure headset is paired and within 10m of device. Recharge headset. Check microphone boom for obstructions.
Headset not turning on	Battery fully discharged.	Connect to charger and allow to charge for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on.
Cannot pair headset	Headset not in pairing mode; device's Bluetooth is off; interference.	Ensure headset LED flashes red/blue. Turn device's Bluetooth off and on. Move away from other wireless devices.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Callers cannot hear me	Microphone muted; microphone not positioned correctly; background noise.	Check if microphone is muted. Adjust microphone boom closer to your mouth. The headset's noise cancellation should handle most background noise.

If issues persist, try resetting the headset (refer to Plantronics support for specific reset procedures) or contacting customer support.
