1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this instruction manual thoroughly before installing, operating, or maintaining your appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

1.1 General Safety Warnings

- Ensure the appliance is unplugged before cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.

1.2 Electrical Safety

- Connect the appliance to an earthed socket protected by a fuse.
- Do not use multiple adapters or extension leads.
- Ensure the power cord is not trapped or damaged.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Blomberg FNT4550 is a 55cm frost-free tall freezer designed for efficient and convenient frozen food storage. Its frost-free technology prevents ice build-up, eliminating the need for manual defrosting.



3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials, including protective films and tapes.
- Check the appliance for any transport damage. Report any damage immediately to your retailer.

3.2 Placement

- Place the freezer on a firm, level surface.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Leave at least 10cm clearance at the back and sides for proper air circulation.
- Avoid placing the freezer in direct sunlight or near heat sources (e.g., radiators, ovens).
- The appliance is designed for freestanding installation.

3.3 Leveling

Adjust the front leveling feet to ensure the appliance is stable and level. This prevents vibrations and excessive noise.

3.4 Initial Power On

- After positioning, wait at least 4 hours before plugging in the appliance. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
- Plug the freezer into a grounded electrical outlet.
- The internal light should illuminate, and the compressor should start running.
- Allow the freezer to operate for 24 hours empty before loading with food to reach the optimal temperature.

4. OPERATING THE FREEZER

4.1 Control Panel

The control panel is located inside the freezer compartment, typically at the top. It allows you to adjust the temperature and activate special functions.

4.2 Temperature Setting

- Press the 'Set' button to cycle through temperature settings. The recommended temperature for a freezer is -18°C.
- The indicator lights will show the current temperature setting.

4.3 Quick Freeze Function

- Use the 'Quick' or 'Quick Freeze' button to rapidly freeze fresh food. This helps to preserve the food's quality and nutrients.
- Activate this function several hours before placing large quantities of fresh food into the freezer.
- The quick freeze function will automatically switch off after approximately 24 hours, or it can be manually deactivated.

4.4 Food Storage Guidelines

- Always wrap food properly to prevent dehydration and odor transfer.
- Do not place hot food directly into the freezer. Allow it to cool down first.
- Avoid overloading the drawers, as this can impede air circulation.
- Refer to the packaging for recommended storage times of frozen foods.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- Interior Cleaning:** Unplug the appliance. Clean the interior regularly with a solution of lukewarm water and a mild, non-abrasive detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before plugging back in.
- Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and a mild detergent. Dry with a soft cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals.

5.2 Defrosting

This appliance features a frost-free system, which means manual defrosting is generally not required. Any minor frost build-up will be automatically removed.

5.3 Door Seal Care

Regularly check and clean the door seals to ensure they are free from food particles and remain flexible. A clean, tight seal helps maintain energy efficiency.

5.4 Power Outage

In case of a power outage, keep the freezer door closed to maintain the internal temperature for as long as possible. The freezer can typically keep food frozen for several hours if the door remains shut.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting service, please check the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Freezer not operating	No power; Plug not inserted correctly; Fuse blown.	Check power supply; Ensure plug is fully inserted; Check household fuse.
Temperature is not cold enough	Door opened too frequently; Large amount of warm food added; Poor ventilation; Temperature setting too high.	Minimize door openings; Allow food to cool before placing in freezer; Ensure adequate clearance around appliance; Adjust temperature setting lower.
Excessive noise	Appliance not level; Objects touching the back of the freezer; Normal operating sounds.	Adjust leveling feet; Move objects away from the back; Gurgling/hissing sounds are normal for refrigerant.
Water on the floor	Drain hole blocked (if applicable); Excessive humidity.	Clear any blockages in the drain hole; Ensure door is closed properly.
