1. Introduction

Welcome to the instruction manual for your Geberit Twico Replacement Kit. This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, function, and maintenance of your new replacement parts. Please read this manual thoroughly before proceeding with installation to ensure correct usage and optimal performance.

2. Product Overview

The Geberit Twico Replacement Kit is designed to replace components within Geberit flush cisterns models 110850 and 111180. This kit includes original Geberit spare parts, ensuring compatibility and reliable operation for your toilet flushing system.

- Direct replacement for Geberit flush cisterns 110850 and 111180.
- Composed of original Geberit spare parts for guaranteed quality and fit.

3. Setup and Installation

This kit is intended for replacement of existing components. Installation should ideally be performed by a qualified professional or an individual with experience in plumbing systems.

1. **Preparation:** Turn off the water supply to the toilet cistern and flush the toilet to empty the cistern. Remove the cistern lid.
2. **Removal of Old Parts:** Carefully disconnect and remove the old flush valve and associated components from the cistern. Note the orientation and connections of the existing parts.
3. **Installation of New Parts:** Refer to the detailed diagram provided with the kit (visible in Image 1) for specific installation steps. Ensure all seals are correctly seated and connections are secure to prevent leaks.
4. **Water Supply:** Once the new components are securely installed, slowly turn the water supply back on and check for any leaks.
5. **Function Test:** Allow the cistern to fill and perform several test flushes to ensure proper operation of the new mechanism.

Important: Always ensure the water supply is turned off before beginning any work inside the cistern.

4. Operating Instructions

Once installed, the Geberit Twico Replacement Kit functions as the core flushing mechanism for your toilet cistern. Its operation is integrated with your existing flush button or lever. Pressing the flush actuator will activate the valve, allowing water to flow from the cistern into the toilet bowl for flushing. The dual-flush functionality (if applicable to your original system and supported by the kit) will be maintained, offering water-saving options.

5. Maintenance

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and efficient operation of your Geberit flushing system.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically inspect the components inside the cistern for mineral buildup or debris. Clean with a soft brush and mild, non-abrasive cleaners if necessary. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage plastic or

rubber parts.

- **Leak Checks:** Regularly check for any signs of leaks, both inside the cistern and around the toilet base. Address any leaks promptly to prevent water waste and potential damage.
- **Component Inspection:** Every few years, or if issues arise, inspect rubber seals and moving parts for wear and tear. Replace any worn components with genuine Geberit spare parts.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues after installing the replacement kit, consider the following common problems and solutions:

- **Toilet constantly running:**
 - Check if the flush valve seal is properly seated and free of debris.
 - Ensure the fill valve is not overfilling the cistern, causing water to overflow into the flush valve. Adjust the fill level if needed.
- **Weak or incomplete flush:**
 - Verify that the flush valve opens fully when activated.
 - Check for any obstructions preventing the valve from operating correctly.
- **Difficulty flushing:**
 - Ensure the connection between the flush button/lever and the flush valve is correct and not binding.

If problems persist, it is recommended to consult a professional plumber or contact Geberit customer support.
