# 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Tefal WM756D12 King Size Semi-Professional Waffle Maker. This appliance is designed to help you create delicious, perfectly cooked Belgian waffles. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

# 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- · Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical hazards, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- . Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

# 3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS AND FEATURES

The Tefal WM756D12 Waffle Maker is designed for convenience and performance. Key features include:

- Semi-Professional Design: Equipped with a rotating handle for easy flipping of the plates, ensuring even cooking and delicious results.
- Adjustable Thermostat: Allows precise temperature control for perfect waffle browning, from light to dark.
- Indicator Light: A practical light indicates when the plates have reached the optimal temperature for cooking.
- Easy to Clean: The non-stick plates are dishwasher-safe for effortless cleaning.
- Compact Storage: Features a foldable handle and a compact design for convenient storage.

# 4. SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the waffle maker and all accessories from its packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Remove the cooking plates and wash them with warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly. Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the waffle maker on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface, away from walls or cabinets to allow for proper ventilation. Ensure the power cord is not tangled or obstructing any movement.

# 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Preheating:** Plug the waffle maker into a suitable electrical outlet. Turn the thermostat to your desired browning level. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the appliance is preheating.
- 2. **Ready Indicator:** The indicator light will turn off or change color (depending on the model) once the waffle maker has reached the set temperature and is ready for use.
- 3. **Pouring Batter:** Open the waffle maker and carefully pour your waffle batter onto the lower cooking plate. Do not overfill to prevent overflow.
- 4. Closing and Rotating: Close the lid. After a few seconds, use the rotating handle to flip the waffle maker 180

- degrees. This ensures even distribution of batter and uniform cooking on both sides.
- 5. **Cooking Time:** Cook for the recommended time based on your recipe and desired crispiness. The adjustable thermostat allows you to fine-tune the cooking process.
- 6. **Removing Waffles:** Once cooked, open the waffle maker and carefully remove the waffles using a non-metallic utensil to avoid damaging the non-stick coating.

# 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your waffle maker.

- . Cool Down: Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- **Dishwasher-Safe Plates:** The non-stick cooking plates are removable and dishwasher-safe for convenient cleaning. Refer to Figure 4 for an example.
- Exterior Cleaning: Wipe the exterior housing with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as these can damage the finish.
- **Storage:** Once clean and dry, the waffle maker can be stored compactly thanks to its foldable handle. Refer to Figure 5 for storage orientation.

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your waffle maker, please consult the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Waffle maker does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power switch off; faulty outlet.	Ensure the appliance is properly plugged in and the power switch is on. Check the electrical outlet with another appliance.
Waffles are not browning evenly.	Insufficient preheating; uneven batter distribution; thermostat setting too low.	Allow the appliance to fully preheat until the indicator light signals readiness.  Ensure batter is spread evenly. Adjust the thermostat to a higher setting.  Ensure the rotating handle is used to flip the plates during cooking.
Waffles stick to the plates.	Plates not properly seasoned; old or incorrect batter recipe; plates not clean.	Ensure plates are clean and lightly greased before use (if not non-stick). Use a fresh, appropriate waffle batter recipe. Clean plates thoroughly after each use.
