INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your Timex Men's Ironman Triathlon Classic 30 38mm Watch. This guide provides detailed instructions to help you understand and utilize all the features of your new timepiece. Designed for durability and performance, this watch is equipped with a 100-hour chronograph, 30-lap memory, 24-hour countdown timer, multiple alarms, and INDIGLO backlight, making it an ideal companion for athletes and active individuals.

Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper setup and operation of your watch.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the various components and buttons of your Timex Ironman watch.

Button Functions:

- **MODE:** Cycles through different watch modes (Time, Chrono, Timer, Alarm).
- **SET/RECALL:** Used to set values in setting modes and recall lap times in chronograph mode.
- **INDIGLO:** Activates the INDIGLO backlight for low-light visibility.
- **STOP/RESET:** Stops timers/chronograph and resets values.
- **START/SPLIT:** Starts timers/chronograph and records split times.

SETUP

1. Setting Time and Date:

1. From the Time mode, press and hold the **SET/RECALL** button until the display flashes.

2. Press the **START/SPLIT** or **STOP/RESET** button to adjust the flashing value (e.g., hour, minute, year, month, day).
3. Press the **MODE** button to move to the next setting.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until all desired settings are adjusted.
5. Press **SET/RECALL** to exit setting mode.

2. Adjusting the Strap:

The resin strap is adjustable to fit various wrist sizes. Use the buckle to find a comfortable and secure fit. Ensure the watch is snug but not too tight to allow for proper blood circulation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Time Display:

In Time mode, the watch displays the current time, day of the week, and date. Press the **INDIGLO** button to illuminate the display in low light conditions.

2. Using the Chronograph (Stopwatch):

1. Press **MODE** until "CHRONO" appears.
2. Press **START/SPLIT** to begin timing.
3. Press **START/SPLIT** again to record a lap/split time (the main timer continues running).
4. Press **STOP/RESET** to pause the chronograph.
5. Press **STOP/RESET** again to reset the chronograph to zero.
6. To recall lap times, press **SET/RECALL** while the chronograph is stopped.

3. Using the Countdown Timer:

1. Press **MODE** until "TIMER" appears.
2. Press and hold **SET/RECALL** to set the countdown duration. Adjust values using **START/SPLIT** or **STOP/RESET**, and move between settings with **MODE**.
3. Press **SET/RECALL** to confirm the timer setting.
4. Press **START/SPLIT** to begin the countdown.
5. Press **STOP/RESET** to pause/resume the timer.
6. When the timer reaches zero, an alarm will sound. Press any button to silence it.

4. Setting Alarms:

Your watch supports 3 daily, weekday, or weekend alarms.

1. Press **MODE** until "ALARM" appears.
2. Press **SET/RECALL** to select Alarm 1, 2, or 3.
3. Press and hold **SET/RECALL** to enter alarm setting mode.
4. Adjust the alarm time and frequency (daily, weekday, weekend) using **START/SPLIT** or **STOP/RESET**, and move between settings with **MODE**.
5. Press **SET/RECALL** to confirm.
6. To turn an alarm ON/OFF, press **START/SPLIT** while in Alarm mode (not setting mode).

5. Water Resistance:

This watch is water resistant to 100 meters (330 feet). It is suitable for swimming and snorkeling. **Do not press any**

buttons underwater as this can compromise the water resistance seal.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch:

Regularly clean your watch with a soft, damp cloth. For resin straps, mild soap and water can be used. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the watch finish or strap.

Battery Replacement:

The watch uses a Lithium Metal battery (included). When the battery needs replacement, it is recommended to take your watch to an authorized Timex service center or a qualified watch repair professional. This ensures the water resistance seal is properly maintained.

Storage:

When not in use for extended periods, store your watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank or dim.	Low or dead battery.	Replace the battery (refer to Maintenance section).
Buttons are unresponsive.	Watch may be in a locked mode or internal malfunction.	Try pressing all buttons firmly. If issue persists, contact customer support.
Time is inaccurate.	Time not set correctly or battery low.	Re-set the time (refer to Setup section). If problem continues, replace battery.
Water inside the watch.	Water resistance compromised (e.g., buttons pressed underwater).	Immediately take the watch to a service center. Do not attempt to dry it yourself.
