INTRODUCTION

The Elgato Thunderbolt 3 Dock is designed to expand the connectivity of your MacBook Pro or Windows notebook. It allows you to connect multiple peripherals, external displays, and charge your laptop simultaneously using a single Thunderbolt 3 cable. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your dock to ensure optimal performance.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Elgato Thunderbolt 3 Dock features a robust aluminum chassis and provides a comprehensive array of ports for enhanced productivity.

Front Panel

- 2x USB 3.0 Ports (Type-A): For connecting standard USB devices.
- 3.5mm Audio Input: For connecting a microphone or other audio input device.
- 3.5mm Audio Output: For connecting headphones or speakers.
- SD Card Reader: Supports full-size SD cards for data transfer.
- MicroSD Card Reader: Supports microSD cards for data transfer.

Rear Panel




Figure 2: Rear view of the Elgato Thunderbolt 3 Dock, highlighting the Gigabit Ethernet, additional USB 3.0, Thunderbolt 3 ports, DisplayPort, and power input.

- Gigabit Ethernet Port: For wired network connectivity.
- 3x USB 3.0 Ports (Type-A): For connecting additional USB devices.
- 2x Thunderbolt 3 Ports (USB-C): One port connects to your computer, providing up to 85W power delivery. The second port can be used for daisy-chaining another Thunderbolt device or connecting a display.

- DisplayPort: For connecting an external display.
- Power Input (20V == 8.5A): Connects to the included power supply unit.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Elgato Thunderbolt 3 Dock:

- 1. **Connect Power:** Plug the included power supply unit into the dock's power input port on the rear panel, then connect it to a wall outlet.
- 2. **Connect to Computer:** Use the provided Thunderbolt 3 cable to connect one of the Thunderbolt 3 ports on the rear of the dock to a Thunderbolt 3 port on your MacBook Pro or Windows notebook. This single cable will provide data, video, and up to 85W of power to your laptop.
- 3. **Connect Peripherals:** Connect your USB devices (keyboard, mouse, external drives), Ethernet cable, and audio devices to the appropriate ports on the dock's front and rear panels.
- 4. **Connect Displays:** Connect your external display(s) to the DisplayPort on the rear of the dock. If using a second display, connect it to the second Thunderbolt 3 port using a compatible adapter (not included).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power Delivery

The dock delivers up to 85W of power to your connected laptop via the Thunderbolt 3 cable. Ensure your laptop's power requirements do not exceed this limit for optimal charging and performance. If your laptop requires more than 85W, it may charge slower or display a warning.

Display Connectivity

The Elgato Thunderbolt 3 Dock supports:

Dual 4K displays at 60Hz (one via DisplayPort, one via the second Thunderbolt 3 port with an adapter).

• A single 5K display at 60Hz (via the second Thunderbolt 3 port with an adapter).

Ensure your computer's graphics card and operating system support the desired display configurations.




Figure 4: Example of a dual monitor setup facilitated by the Elgato Thunderbolt 3 Dock.

USB Ports

The dock provides five USB 3.0 Type-A ports (two front, three rear) for connecting various USB peripherals. The Thunderbolt 3 USB-C ports also support USB devices, offering high-speed data transfer.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power/Charging:** Ensure the power supply is securely connected to both the dock and a working wall outlet. Verify the Thunderbolt 3 cable is properly connected to your laptop and the dock.
- **Display Not Detected:** Check all display cables and connections. Ensure your laptop's drivers are up to date. Confirm your laptop and operating system support the desired display resolution and refresh rate.
- **Peripherals Not Working:** Disconnect and reconnect the peripheral. Try connecting it to a different USB port on the dock. Ensure necessary drivers for the peripheral are installed on your computer.
- Intermittent Connectivity: Ensure all cables are securely connected. Avoid placing the dock near strong electromagnetic interference sources.
- Slow USB Performance: While the dock offers high-speed USB 3.0 and Thunderbolt 3 ports, overall performance can be affected by the number of devices connected and the bandwidth available through your computer's Thunderbolt 3 port.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Keep the dock in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures.
- Clean the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using liquid cleaners or solvents.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the dock. This will void the warranty.
