# SVINZ Dementia Clock (Model SDC008W) Instruction Manual

Your guide to setting up and using your SVINZ Digital Day Clock.

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the SVINZ Dementia Clock. This 8-inch high-resolution digital alarm clock is designed to clearly display the time, day, date, week, month, and year, making it ideal for seniors, individuals with vision impairment, or those experiencing memory loss. It features multiple alarms, an auto-dimming option, and versatile mounting capabilities.

## SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your SVINZ Dementia Clock:

1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove the clock and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure you have the clock unit, power adapter, and user manual.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power adapter to the DC IN port on the back of the clock. Plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet. The clock will power on automatically.
3. **Initial Display:** Upon first power-on, the clock may display a default time and date.
4. **Positioning:** The clock can be placed on a desk or bedside table using its integrated stand, or mounted on a wall using the two hanging holes on the back.

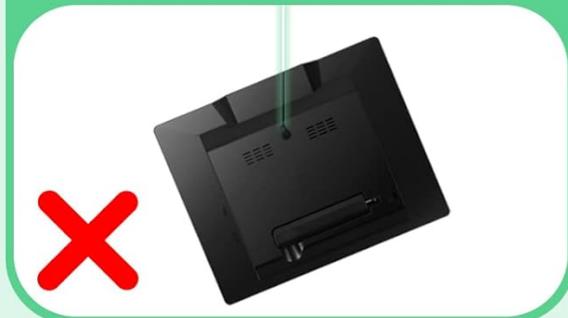

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SVINZ Dementia Clock features intuitive controls for easy operation. All settings are accessed via the buttons on the back of the unit.

### Setting Time and Date

1. Press the **MENU** button on the back of the clock to enter the settings menu.
2. Use the **UP** and **DOWN** arrow buttons to navigate through the menu options (Set Time, Set Date, Time Mode, etc.).
3. Press the **OK** button to select an option.
4. Use the **LEFT** and **RIGHT** arrow buttons to adjust values (e.g., hours, minutes, month, day, year).
5. Press **OK** to confirm your selection and move to the next setting, or **MENU** to exit the current setting.

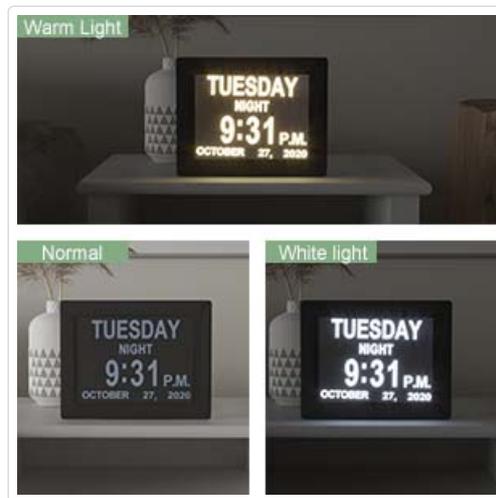
## Time Mode (12/24 Hour)

In the settings menu, select "Time Mode" and use the arrow buttons to switch between 12-hour and 24-hour formats.

## Alarm Settings

The clock supports up to 5 individual alarms. Each alarm can be set with a specific time and frequency (e.g., Once, Everyday, Mon-Fri, Weekend, Off).

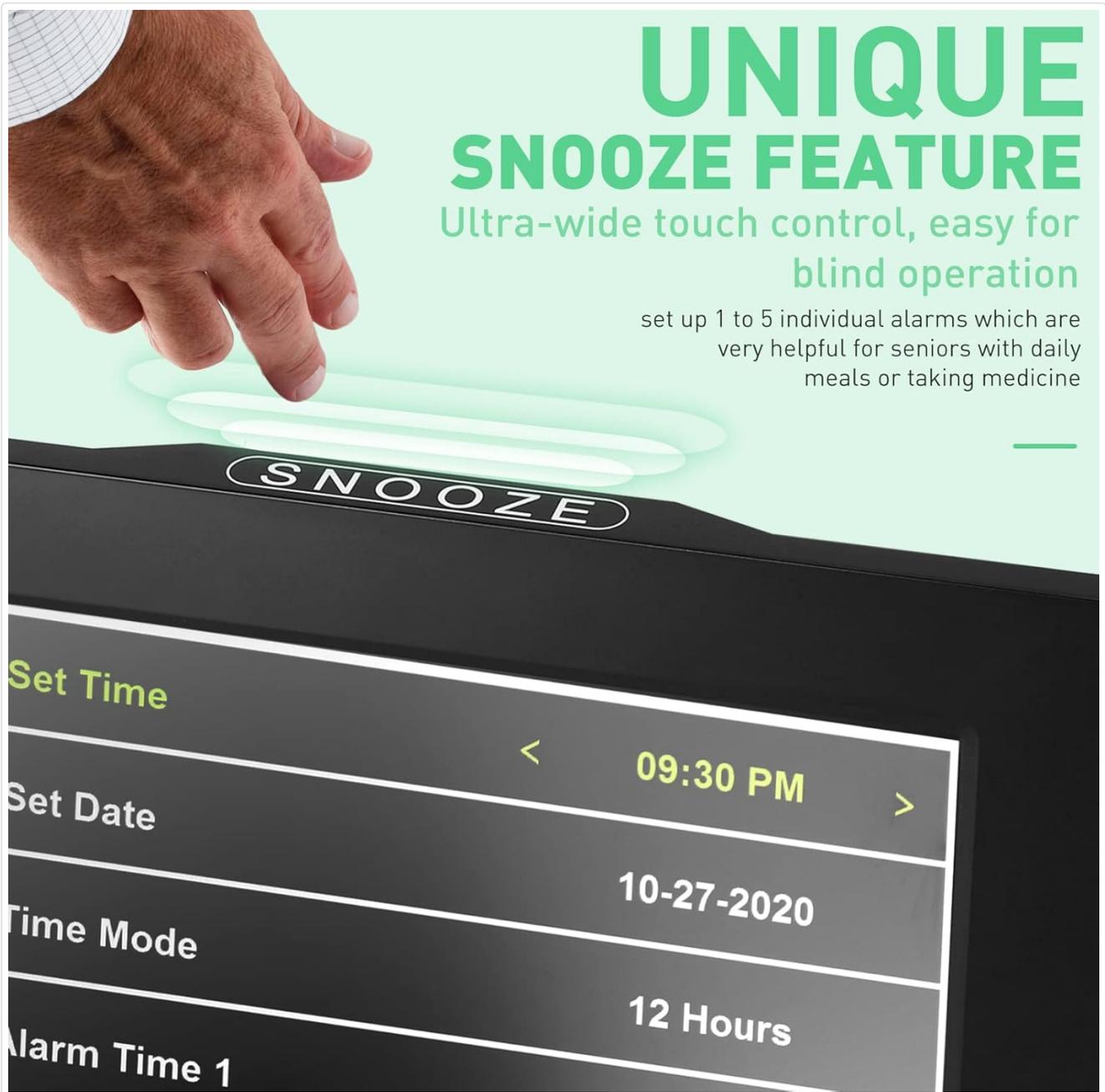
1. From the settings menu, select "Alarm Time 1" (or any other alarm).
2. Adjust the alarm time using the **LEFT** and **RIGHT** arrow buttons.
3. Select "Alarm Frequency" to choose how often the alarm repeats.
4. To disable an alarm, set its frequency to "Off".

## Snooze Function

The clock features an easy-to-access SNOOZE button on the top. When an alarm sounds, press the SNOOZE button to temporarily silence it. You can set the snooze duration in the settings menu (3 or 5 times).

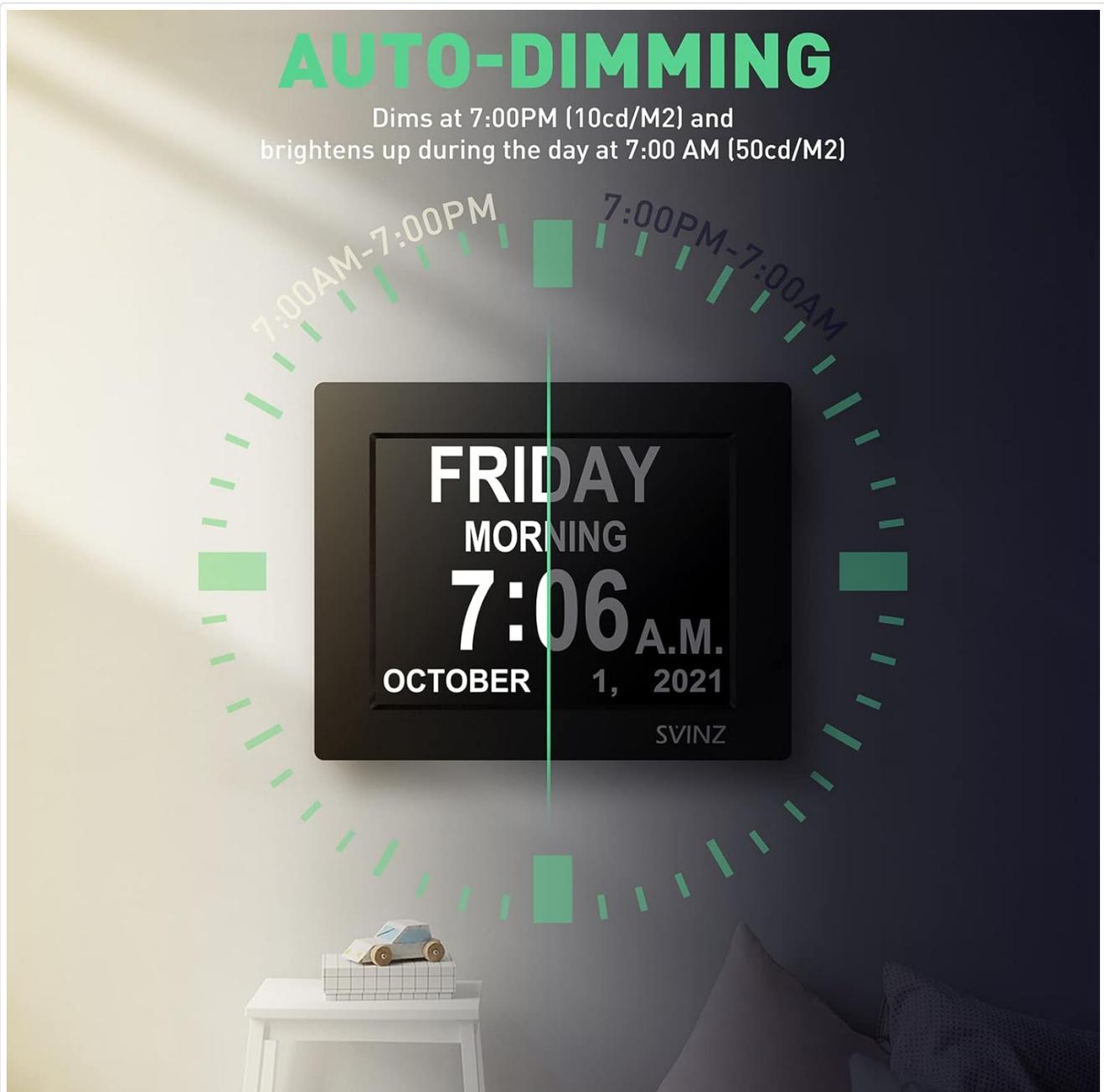

## Auto-Dimming

The clock can automatically adjust its brightness. It dims at 7:00 PM and brightens at 7:00 AM. This feature can be turned off in the settings menu if you prefer a consistent brightness level.

## Color Mode

Choose your preferred display color from the settings menu: White, Yellow, or Black (white text on black background).

## Language Settings

The clock supports 8 languages: English, Français, Deutsche, Italiano, Polskie, Español, Nederlands, and Cymraeg. Select your desired language in the settings menu.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the screen and exterior of the clock. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Power:** Always use the provided power adapter. Disconnect power during electrical storms or when not in use for extended periods.

- **Placement:** Avoid placing the clock in direct sunlight or near heat sources, as this may affect its performance and lifespan.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Clock not powering on:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the clock and a working electrical outlet.
- **Display is dim or too bright:** Check the "Auto-Dimming" setting in the menu. Adjust the brightness manually or turn auto-dimming off if preferred.
- **Alarm not sounding:** Verify that the alarm time and frequency are correctly set and that the alarm is not set to "Off". Check the volume setting.
- **Incorrect time/date:** Enter the settings menu and manually adjust the time and date.
