## 1. INTRODUCTION

This professional-grade styling tool is designed to provide smooth, straight hair with enhanced shine and reduced heat damage. Its advanced infrared technology and titanium plates work together to deliver salon-quality results efficiently. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and optimal performance of your new flat iron.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

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To reduce the risk of electric shock, burns, fire, or injury, always follow these basic safety precautions:

- **DANGER:** Always unplug the appliance immediately after using and before cleaning.
- Do not use while bathing or in a shower.

## 4. SETUP

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1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the CROC Infrared Flat Iron from its packaging. Ensure all components are present and undamaged.
2. **Inspect:** Check the power cord and plug for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Placement:** Place the flat iron on a heat-resistant, flat surface away from water or flammable materials.
4. **Plug In:** Insert the power plug into a standard electrical outlet (110-240V, 50/60Hz).

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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1. **Preparation:** Ensure your hair is clean, dry, and free of tangles. For best results and heat protection, apply a heat protectant spray.
2. **Power On:** Press and hold the power button until the digital display illuminates.
3. **Set Temperature:** Use the temperature control buttons (+ / -) to select your desired heat setting.
  - **Fine/Chemically Treated Hair:** 280-330°F (138-165°C)

- **Wavy/Medium Textured Hair:** 310-390°F (154-199°C)
- **Thick/Coarse Hair:** 390-450°F (199-232°C)

Allow the iron to heat up to the selected temperature. The display will indicate when it's ready.

4. **Section Hair:** Divide your hair into small, manageable sections (approximately 1-2 inches wide).
5. **Straighten:** Take one section of hair and place it between the heating plates, close to the roots. Gently clamp the iron shut and glide it slowly and smoothly down the entire length of the hair, from root to tip. For optimal results and to minimize heat exposure, aim for a single pass per section.
6. **Repeat:** Continue with the remaining sections of hair until desired style is achieved.
7. **Power Off:** After use, press and hold the power button until the display turns off. Unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet.
8. **Cool Down:** Allow the flat iron to cool completely on a heat-resistant surface before storing.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Flat iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in, power outlet issue, or internal fault.	Ensure the iron is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check your home's circuit breaker. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Hair is not straightening effectively.	Incorrect temperature setting, too large sections, or hair not fully dry.	Increase temperature for thicker hair (refer to Operating Instructions). Ensure hair is completely dry. Work with smaller sections.
Hair feels static or frizzy after styling.	Lack of moisture, product buildup, or environmental factors.	Ensure plates are clean. Consider using a leave-in conditioner or anti-frizz serum. The infrared technology should help reduce static.
