INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the safe and effective use, care, and maintenance of your Contigo TwistSeal Glaze 16 oz Vacuum-Insulated Stainless Steel Travel Mug. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

The Contigo TwistSeal Glaze Travel Mug is designed to keep beverages hot for up to 7 hours or cold for up to 18 hours, thanks to its THERMALOCK™ vacuum insulation. It features a TwistSeal™ lid for leak-proof transport and a CleanGuard™ spout cover for hygiene.

Key Features:

- **THERMALOCK™ Vacuum Insulation:** Keeps drinks hot for up to 7 hours and cold for up to 18 hours.
- **TwistSeal™ Lid:** Provides a leak-proof seal when closed, ideal for on-the-go use.
- **CleanGuard™ Spout Cover:** Protects the drinking spout from dirt and germs.
- **Easy-Clean Lid:** The lid completely opens for thorough cleaning with no separate parts to disassemble.
- **Car Cup Holder Friendly:** Designed to fit most car cup holders.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Hot Liquids:** When filled with hot liquids, keep out of reach of children. Contents may be very hot.
- **Pressure Buildup:** Do not overfill. Hot beverages can create internal pressure, which may cause the lid to open unexpectedly or spray contents.
- **Microwave/Freezer:** Do not place in microwave or freezer.
- **Carbonated Beverages:** Not intended for use with carbonated beverages, as pressure buildup can cause the lid to open unexpectedly.
- **Cleaning:** Always ensure the lid is securely closed before shaking or transporting.
- **Damage:** Do not use if the mug or lid is damaged.

PARTS IDENTIFICATION

Your Contigo TwistSeal Glaze Travel Mug consists of two main components:

1. **Mug Body:** The vacuum-insulated stainless steel container.
2. **TwistSeal™ Lid:** The top component with the drinking spout and sealing mechanism.

SETUP

Initial Cleaning:

Before first use, wash all parts with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for detailed cleaning instructions.

Assembling the Mug:

Ensure the lid is properly aligned and securely threaded onto the mug body. Turn clockwise until tight to prevent leaks.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Filling the Mug:

1. Unscrew the TwistSeal lid from the mug body.
2. Fill the mug with your desired beverage. Do not overfill; leave approximately 1 inch (2.5 cm) of space from the top rim to allow for the lid.
3. Screw the lid back onto the mug body, turning clockwise until it is securely tightened.

Using the TwistSeal™ Lid:

- **To Open for Drinking:** Twist the top part of the lid counter-clockwise until the drinking spout is exposed. The CleanGuard™ cover will retract.
- **To Close and Seal:** Twist the top part of the lid clockwise until the drinking spout is fully covered and the lid clicks into the locked position. This ensures a leak-proof seal.

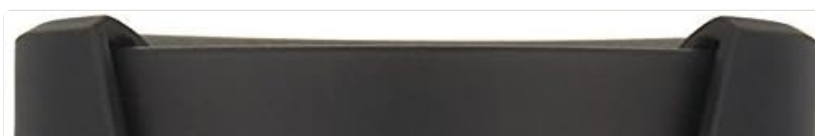




Image: A close-up of the Contigo TwistSeal Glaze lid, showing the spout in the closed and sealed position.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your travel mug.

Lid Cleaning:

- The TwistSeal lid is **top-rack dishwasher safe**.
- For manual cleaning, twist the lid to the open position. The internal mechanism is designed to open fully for easy access to all crevices. Wash with warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly. No need to disassemble small parts.

Mug Body Cleaning:

- The stainless steel mug body is **hand wash only**.
- Wash with warm, soapy water using a bottle brush if necessary to reach the bottom. Rinse thoroughly.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or scrubbers on the mug body, as this may damage the finish.

Drying and Storage:

Allow all parts to dry completely before reassembling or storing to prevent odor or mildew buildup. Store with the lid off or slightly ajar to allow air circulation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mug is leaking.	Lid not securely tightened. Spout not fully closed. Seal is dirty or damaged.	Ensure lid is tightly screwed on. Twist spout clockwise until fully closed. Clean lid thoroughly, checking for debris or damage to seals.
Beverage not staying hot/cold.	Lid not properly sealed. Mug body damaged (e.g., dented).	Verify the lid is fully closed and sealed. Inspect mug body for damage that could compromise insulation.
Difficulty twisting the lid.	Debris or residue in the lid mechanism.	Clean the lid thoroughly, ensuring no dried beverage or food particles are obstructing the twist mechanism.
